Notice of Race – Including Amendment 1 and 2

Organizing Authority: Tahoe Yacht Club

1 RULES

- **1.1** The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- **1.2** RRS 40.1 applies.
- 1.3 RRS 44.1 is changed as follows: A boat may take a One-Turn Penalty as described in RRS 44.2 when she may have broken a rule of part 2 while racing. However, if a boat breaks SI 8.4 (restricted start-finish line) she may take a Two-Turns Penalty as described in RRS 44.2 and continue racing.
- **1.4** U.S. Prescriptions to RRS 63.2 and 63.4 are deleted.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 In accordance with RRS 75 boats must be entered by competitors who are members of appropriate sailing clubs. Those failing to comply are encouraged to join the Tahoe Yacht Club. Another alternative would be to join the Scuttlebutt Sailing Club at no charge:

- **2.2** This is a one-design series open to class legal boats.
- **2.3** ILCA Standard Rigs, ILCA Radial Rigs, RS Zests, and Melges 15s are eligible.
- **2.4** ILCA Standards and ILCA Radials may select either rig for any race.
- **2.5** Three boats must be registered to qualify for a start.

4.2 Three races are scheduled for each of the seven evenings, although additional races may be run if conditions permit.

6 VENUE

- 6.1 The racing areas will be near Tahoe City between Dollar Point and Tahoe Tavern with the start off the US Coast Guard Station
- **6.2** The courses will be around drop marks set by the race committee as described in the sailing instructions.

7 SCORING

- 7.1 21 races (three per evening) are scheduled although up to 28 races (four per evening) may be run.
- **7.2** Six completed races constitutes a series.
- **7.3** For every five races completed, the worst score shall be discarded. If fewer than five races are completed, no scores will be discarded. This changes A2.1.

8 LAUNCHING

Launching will be available at the Tahoe City Public Utility District launch ramp adjacent to the US Coast Guard station in Lake Forest, near Tahoe City.

9 PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded based on entries.

10 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The Tahoe Yacht Club and any other organizing authority for the regatta will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
