Registration. You are cordially invited to join us for the Coconut Grove Sailing Club's 2024 Annual One Design Regatta.

CGSC Dinghy and Flying Scot Fall Series entrants and BBYRA registered One Design boats are already registered.

Non-BBYRA registrants: registration will be \$45.00 and please register at

We are expecting entries in the Etchells, J24s/Sonars, J70s, Snipes, Flying Scots, Finn, Sunfish and ILCA Classes. ~~Flying Scots will also be sailing for the Sally Russell Trophy and the Charlie Fowler Trophy. Snipes will be sailing for the Gonzalo "Old Man" Diaz Trophy.~~ Three races are scheduled, weather permitting.

Awards. Prizes will be awarded to the top 3 boats in any class with 10 or more entries, to the top 2 boats in any class with 5 to 9 entries and to the top boat in any fleet with less than 5 entries..

Sailing Instructions. Racing will be governed by the *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*, except as modified and supplemented by the Biscayne Bay Yacht Racing Association Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions 2023-24, General Conditions and Sailing Instructions, Part II – Sailing Instructions: One Designs (available at www.bbyra.net). No separate Sailing Instructions will be issued.

Protests. Protests and requests for redress should be initiated by filling out the online Protest form [here](#). Additionally, if a diagram is required, it should be photographed and emailed to Protest@cgsc.org. Alternatively, a completed Protest form may be photographed and emailed to Protest@cgsc.org. A protest email is sufficient (instead of the actual protest form) if it includes the name or sail numbers of the boat protesting and being protested, the incident, where and when the incident occurred, and (if possible) a cell phone number suitable for texting. Protests shall be delivered within 1 hour after the Race Committee Signal Boat docks. The protest time limit and a list of protests received will be posted on the official notice board at https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/28439#_newsroom. Hearings will be held as soon as practicable after racing in the protest hearing room. This changes BBYRA 15.2.

PLEASE NOTE: No races will be excluded..

GENERAL INFORMATION

- On each race day, each boat must check-in by sailing past the stern of the Race Committee boat on starboard tack prior to the warning signal of the first race in which it will be competing. No check-ins will be accepted during a starting sequence.
- CGSC parking is limited to Members only. Parking is available around the circle (metered) or at the Public Parking Garage next to the Sonesta. Class boats and trailers may be stored in the boat storage areas.
- Two electric hoists are available at CGSC. A public boat ramp is located adjacent to the Club property. One floating dock is available at the Club.
