NOTICE OF RACE

August 5-8, 2024

1) Rules: The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.

2) Eligibility: All participants must be age 17 or under or in the 2024 high school class. All ages as of August 5, 2024. Participants may sail in only the South or North Regattas but are strongly encouraged to join in the fun for all four days!

3) Classes:

3.1 Laser Radial

3.2 Club 420

3.3 Optimist White Fleet (Age 10 & under)

3.4 Optimist Blue Fleet (Ages 11 & 12)

3.5 Optimist Red Fleet (Ages 13-15)

3.6 Optimist Green Fleet (1st year sailors age 15 and under)

4) Entry Fees (for C-420s, stated fee below must be paid both by skipper and crew)

Per River, before August 2: \$80, on or after August 3: \$95

Both Rivers, before August 2: \$125, on or after August 3: \$135

5) Registration Forms:

5.2 There will be no paper forms submitted (all registration must be done online). There will be no registration the morning of the races, parents must register and pay online by 11:59 pm on August 4 for the South River (SSYC) and by 11:59 pm on August 6 for the North River (MBC).

5.3 Entry fee shall be paid by credit card online at the time of registration.

5.4 Entry fee includes lunch for sailors only each day. Sailors should bring their own reusable water bottle, US Coast Guard certified PFD, and sunscreen. No plastic water bottles will be provided but filling stations will be made available.

5.5 Additional lunches for parents/siblings may be purchased at registration for \$10/day.

8) Scoring:

8.1 The Low Point System will apply.

8.2 Five races are scheduled for the South River and the North River (10 total). On water race committee will judge if races can be extended or shortened due to weather. The Green Fleet will sail a total of 6 races per River.

8.3 One race is required to be completed to constitute a Regatta.

(a) When fewer than five (5) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of his/her race scores on each river.

(b) When five (5) or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of his/her race scores excluding his/her worst score on each river.

(c) For sailors racing both rivers, when fewer than five (5) races have been completed in total, a boat's series score will be the total of his/her scores. When five (5) or more have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of his/her race scores excluding his/her worst score. When ten (10) or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst two (2) scores.

9) Awards:

9.1 Awards will be presented for the South River Participants, the North River Participants, and The Overall Two River Sweepstakes Participants.

9.2 Awards shall be for the skipper (and, if applicable, crew) of the top five places in each division except Lasers with respect to which only the top place will receive an award.
