# 2024 Notice of Race

## 1. ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

South Shore Yacht Club (SSYC) is the organizing authority for the Sunday Sailing Series.

## 2. RULES

- 2.1 The Series will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing, (*RRS*), the rules of the Performance Handicap Racing Fleet of Southern California (PHRF), and the Notice of Race, except as altered by the Sailing Instructions, as found at:

  The Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024 US Sailing
- 2.2 The Series is classified as a Category "A" Event in accordance with ISAF Regulation 20.
- 2.3 Boats are subject to inspection by the appropriate fleet coordinator to ensure conformity to the applicable class rules, bylaws and/or measurement certificates.
- 2.4 RRS 55 is changed by adding the following sentence to the rule: "However, discarding elastic or wool bands when setting a sail is permitted."
- 2.5 The US Sailing Safety Equipment Requirements (USSER) Coastal Category will apply, except as modified below. USSER is available at

#### 3. CLASSES

The fleet will be divided into appropriate classes based on the PHRF Area D Random Leg Course (RLC) Ratings

**4. ELIGIBILITY** Each entrant must be a member of PHRF of Southern California and have a valid rating, and be a member of an SCYA Member Yacht Club or a USSA recognized yacht club if not a resident of Area J.

#### **5. ENTRY FEE**

5.1 The entry fee is \$40.00.

#### 6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available not later than one (1) week prior to the first race on the SSYC website at <a href="https://www.SouthShoreYC.com">www.SouthShoreYC.com</a>.

## 7. SCHEDULE AND COURSES

- 7.1 Any change to the schedule of races will be posted by 1900 hours on the day before the race on the SSYC website (www.SouthShoreYC.com).
- 7.2 The races are scheduled to be sailed on August 4<sup>th</sup>, September 8<sup>th</sup> and October 13<sup>th</sup>.
- 7.3 The first warning signal each day is scheduled for 1255 hours.
- 7.4 Random Leg courses will be sailed.
- 7.5 The Start/Finish line will be in the vicinity of the Coral Street dock on Balboa Island and Racing Mark N.

## 8. PENALTIES

RRS 44.1 and RRS 44.2 shall apply.

#### 9. SCORING

- 9.1 Scoring will be according to RRS A4.1 Low Point System for each day's race
- 9.2 The races will be scored using the PHRF Area D RLC Rating
- 9.3 For boats rated without a spinnaker, the races will be scored using the PHRF Area D RLC Rating plus the boat's Non-Spinnaker Offset
- 9.4 There are no throw-outs. This changes RRS A2.
- 9.5 RRS A9 shall not apply.

#### 10. PRIZES

- 10.1 Trophies for the Series will be awarded after the last race.
- 10.2 A 2-boat class will awarded one trophy. A class of 3-5 boats will receive first and second place trophies. A class of 6 or more boats will receive first, second and third place trophies.
