NOTICE OF RACE

1) RULES

- a) The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* and including the [DragonFlite 95 Restricted Class Rules](#) (DF95-RCR).
- b) RRS Appendix E will apply.

2) ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- a) The regatta is open to all DragonFlite 95 boats.
- b) Eligible competitors may register by completing the online entry form located at: [Registration for Lakewood Yacht Club : 2024 Texas DragonFlite 95 Championship \(regattanetwork.com\)](#)
- b) Entry forms and fees are due by Friday September 6th at 1700 hours.
- c) Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Race Committee.
- d) The following restrictions on the number of boats apply: Forty-five (45). A waiting list will be established, and the Race Committee reserves the right to increase the number of competitors.

3) FEES

- a) The entry fee of \$70 is due at the time of registration and includes lunch on Saturday and Sunday along with 2 drink tickets.
- b) Immediately following racing on Saturday we will have free appetizers and free keg beer available for participants either by the LYC pool or at the upper deck area.

- a) The scoring system is the AMYA Heat Management System (HMS).
b) The fleet will be divided into heats of no more than 18 boats

9) PRIZES

Prizes will be given to the top five finishers.
