A. Rules

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

B. Eligibility and Entry

All Catalina 22 are eligible and may enter the regatta by completing the registration and paying the required fees on Regatta Network online at: www.regattanetwork.com

Silver Division open to any competitor who has not won a Catalina 22 class sanctioned event, and Gold Division available to any competitor.

C. Fees

Before December 15 - \$50.00

From December 15 - January 17 - \$75.00

After January 17 - \$100.00

Registration includes 1 T-Shirt and two drink tickets.

E. Venue.

The regatta will be held in the vicinity of where the St. John's River meets Lake George, south of Georgetown, Florida. Regatta headquarters will be at the Idle Awhile Resort in Georgetown, Florida. Idle Awhile has available dockage, a boat ramp, lodging (**all rooms held for regatta entrants until Nov. 1, 2024, when reservations are opened to the public on a first-come, first-served basis, 9 rooms left at this time...**), restaurant and bar with indoor or outdoor seating, and a band shell for entertainment. Saturday dinner: order off of menu beginning at 5 pm (ribeye special). Breakfast from menu at 7:00 am.

G. Courses

Courses will be included in the sailing instructions.

H. Scoring

Scoring will be as provided in Appendix A of the RRS, with one modification. The final race of the series will count for double points. This modifies Appendix A4. One race is required to be completed to constitute a regatta.

I. Radio Communication

Except in emergencies, a boat shall neither make radio transmission about the race while racing nor receive radio communications that are not available to all boats. This rule applies to cellphones.

The Race Committee may communicate on VHF Channel 69.

J. Prizes

Trophies will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place finishers in each fleet of five or more boats.

A perpetual trophy will be awarded to the 1st Place Finisher overall.

A separate award will be given to the winner of the night race.

K. Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4 of the Racing Rules of Sailing, "Decision to Race." Participants will sign a waiver recognizing their understanding of this rule.
