# **SAILING INSTRUCTIONS (SI)**

#### 1. **RULES**

- 1.1. A boat is permitted to use propulsion, by engine or any other method, when she may be in a position to impede the safe passage of a vessel utilizing a Traffic Separation Scheme (TSS), provided the boat does not gain a significant advantage in the race.
- 1.2. Change NoR 1.5 as follows: Delete "Subject to approval or modification" and replace with "As approved" (see "Supplemental Information 10.1").
- **1.3.** NoR 11.2 is deleted in its entirety and replaced with:
  - 1.3.1. ORC classes will be scored utilizing the ORC Weather Routing Scoring (WRS) system (see "Supplemental Information 10.2"). This system will be used even if the race is shortened.
  - 1.3.2. The PHRF-NW Class(es) will be scored utilizing the conditional rating values (B Factor) for heavy air or predominantly off the wind (B = 480), average conditions (B = 550), very light or predominantly up wind (B = 600), or a blended average (B = ?) for highly variable conditions. The B Factor will be determined by the race committee from wind speed/direction reporting stations throughout the course, that best reflect the sailing conditions over the majority of the course. This decision shall not be grounds for redress by a boat. This changes RRS 61.1(a).

#### 2. **CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

**2.1.** Any change to the sailing instructions will be posted before 1800 on the day prior to when it will take effect.

#### 3. **COMMUNICATIONS WITH COMPETITORS**

3.1. On the water, the race committee intends to monitor and communicate with competitors on VHF radio channel 71. Failure to hail, or the failure to hear such a hail shall not constitute an improper action or omission for a request for redress. This changes RRS 61.4(b)(1).

#### 4. SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

- **4.1.** Signals made ashore will be displayed at the Port of Ilwaco Marina Office.
- 4.2. When Race Signal flag "AP" is displayed ashore, '1 minute' is replaced with 'not less than 60 minutes' in Race Signals AP.

#### **SCHEDULE OF RACES** 5.

**5.1.** The scheduled time of the warning signal is 0955.

#### 6. **CLASS FLAGS**

**6.1.** There will be no Class flags.

# 7. THE START

- **7.1.** A boat's YB Tracker will transmit a lat/lon and PDT (UTC -7 hours) when it crosses the virtual start line. This data will be used to determine if a boat started properly.
- **7.2.** In the event of a significant discrepancy between a boat's observed start time compared with that reported by the YB Tracker, competitors may request a <u>Scoring Inquiry</u>.
- **7.3.** A boat that does not start within 60 minutes of her starting time will be scored Did Not Start without a hearing. This changes RRS A5.1.

# 8. THE FINISH

- **8.1.** A boat's YB Tracker will transmit a lat/lon and PDT (UTC -7 hours) when it rounds the Duntze Rock Virtual AtoN and when it crosses the virtual finish line. This data will be used to determine a boat's finish time.
- **8.2.** In the event of a significant discrepancy between a boat's observed finish time compared with that reported by the YB Tracker, competitors may request a **Scoring Inquiry**.
- **8.3.** It will be up to the discretion of the race committee in conjunction with the protest committee to determine the finish time to be used. Evidence of a boat's track, other than the YB Track, may be requested. This evidence can be, but is not limited to, a boat's navigation software log file, testimony or evidence from other boats, personal race tracker or AIS logs.

# 9. HEARING REQUESTS

- 9.1. Hearing request forms shall be filled & submitted via the at the Official Notice Board.
- **9.2.** For each class, the protest time limit is 60 minutes after the last boat in that class has finished.
- **9.3.** Notices will be posted at the <u>Official Notice Board</u> to inform competitors of hearings in which they are parties or named as witnesses. Hearings may be held in person or virtually at a time to be determined after any requests are received.
- **9.4.** Notices of protest by a committee will be posted at the <u>Official Notice Board</u> to inform boats under RRS 60.2(d).
