



2025 HOBIE 16 NORTH AMERICAN CHAMPIONSHIPS PYC ARRIVAL WEIGH-IN INFORMATION

G'day Hobie 16 Sailors,

Gonna be a rockin' event at PYC for the 2025 H16 NACs. Before you roll up (see what I did there?) check out the following arrival & weigh-in rules, regulations, procedures, and commandments for the event.

Upon arrival, proceed to parking / launching/weighing area as directed. Boats will be weighed mast down, so weighing in before rigging is not only recommended, but required 'cause otherwise you'll have a hard time getting the pointy thing under the weigh-in tent.

NAC Weigh-in is scheduled for Saturday September27th and Sunday September 28th from 0900-1700 but the crack weigh in crew has decided to get there a little early for the event so keep your eyes peeled and you'll see us setup for fellow early birds on the afternoon of Friday Sept. 26th.

- Prepare boat for weigh-in and wheel to designated weigh-in area.
- Both Skipper & Crew are expected to assist with boat weigh-in and have crew weights recorded.
- Open portholes and drain hulls
- Put all required equipment on tramp in plain sight (sails, blocks, rudders, tiller extensions & crossbar)
- Please, NO other equipment including tools, sail bags, covers, PFDs/throwables, clothes, wetsuits, beer coolers, blenders, outboard motors, or hyper-drives NOTHING else on tramp for weigh-in.
- If corrector weights are required for boat and/or crew, those weights must be weighed and recorded.
- Wet boats will not be weighed. Move to staging area until boat is dry.

After weigh-in you will be issued with your weigh-in paperwork for your boat and crew which you'll need at registration, you can then move your boat to rigging area adjacent to shore launch. Trailer parking area will be identified.

Gonna be a great week out on beautiful Pensacola Bay, some fine competition on hand, looking forward to seeing everyone as they pass through the "Weigh-in House of Pain", bring along a nice legal boat and come talk story with us.
