Rendezvous: At 1830 at Region 1 Mark B (RGR 3 Buoy) at Turkey Point.

Radio: Boats should monitor VHF 71 for courtesy communications from the Race Committee.

Start: Between orange flag on Race Committee boat and Region 1 Mark "B" (RGR). If code flag "L" is displayed, the starting line may be moved to between orange flag on Race Committee boat and another navigation aid or a temporary drop mark.

Signals: RRS 26 (Starting Races). Class starts may be added/combined/split based on entries.

Cruising classes are single headsail. Class flag for cruising will be white.*

Course: Designated by letters and numbers displayed on the Race Committee boat. Special race buoy drop-marks or government marks based on Region 1 Standard Racing Marks (see CBYRA Green Book).

Finish: Between orange flag on Race Committee boat and last posted mark, unless course is shortened after the start at a designated mark of the course.

Time Limit: 4:30 hour maximum time limit from the starting time for each class shall be imposed for all boats in a class. At the discretion of the Race Committee this time limit may be adjusted, depending on time constraints resulting from any postponements. This changes RRS 35.

Rules: This regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2025-2028 (RRS). RRS 63.7, Conflict between Rules, is replaced by, "*If there is a conflict between the Event Sailing Instructions and the Notice Of Race, the Event Sailing Instructions shall apply.*" All changes to this NOR will be posted on the Regatta Network website prior to Saturday August 9, 2025.

Protests: Written protests must be submitted to the Race Committee via email within 3 hours of returning to the NERYC dock or home port. Verbal notice of protest delivered to RC boat at finish.

Awards: Awards will be for 1st place for classes with 3 boats registered, 1st and 2nd place for classes with 5 boats registered, and 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place for classes with 7+ boats

Social: A post-race breakfast will be held at NERYC. TBD per person. Free dockage and/or mooring available to all participants.

Other: Event Sailing Instructions and results will be available on Regatta Network.
