

HOUSTON YACHT CLUB SAILING INSTRUCTIONS Revognah

In Memory of P/C Mike G. Bordelon

1. RULES

This event will be governed by the Revognah Rules Of Sailing (RRS 1998-1898), the prescriptions of the HYC Fleet Surgeon, the Notice of Happy Hour, the rules of the various glasses, except as any of these are changed by the State Legislature. The event is designated Catastrophe A One.

2. ENTRIES

Eligible boats may be entered by the crews having a hangover.

3. NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

Notices to Competitors will be posted on the official Race Information notice board located on the north wall of the north jetty.

4. CHANGES IN SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Any changes to these Sailing Instructions will be kept in strict confidence by the Race Committee.

5. IDENTIFICATION

Each boat shall try to identify herself as best as possible. This modifies Rule 7³/₄.

6. SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

6.1. All signals made ashore shall be displayed from the main yardarm turnbuckle on the dead part of the lawn of the Houston Yacht Club. Signal flags may or may not be displayed either alone or together or beneath or above one or more line or circle flags. If displayed alone or together, the signal flag shall apply to some or all racing lines. If displayed beneath or above one or more line or circle flags, the signal flag shall apply only to the racing line(s) whose flag(s) are displayed or not displayed. It should be perfectly clear what to do. Line flags shall be as follows:

Cruising Line	Numeral Pennant "1" over "N" over "Z" under "2"
One-Design Line	Numeral Pennant "2" over "F" over "U" under "7"
Dinghy Line	Numeral Pennant "3" over "V" over "Y" under "4"
All Line(s)	Numeral Pennant "1" over "2" over "3" over "ψ (θ,μ)dθdμ"

6.2. Code Flag "AP" (Answering Pennant) with two sound signals (one when lowered) means "The race is underway and you missed out".

7. SCHEDULE OF RACES

7.1. Races will be scheduled in accordance with day and time.

7.2. Classes and starting sequences will be announced at the club bar.

8. RACING AREA, COURSES, MARKS

8.1. The location of the race area will be wherever the Race Committee wants it to be.

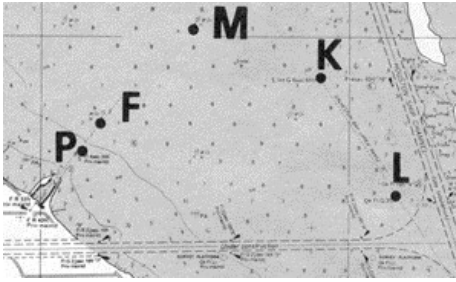
8.2. Courses: Of which there is a possibility of 4.

Red: Carry all marks to port.

Green: Carry all marks to starboard.

Courses will be signaled from the committee boat with a red or green flag over a number 1 or 2 numeral pennant.

Marks for the course will be **K**, **L**, and an **Orange Thing**.



- Red/1 Start - L - K - Finish
- Green/1 Start - K - L - Finish
- Red/2 Start - L - K - Orange Thing - L - K - Finish
- Green/2 Start - K - L - Orange Thing - K - L - Finish

9. THE START

- 9.1. The starting line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the Race Committee boat at the starboard end and an orange semi-cubical parabolic bihedron at the port end.
- 9.2. A boat shall start not earlier than her starting signal.

10. INDIVIDUAL RECALL

As a courtesy to the Race Committee, the Race Committee will not take any phone calls..

11. GENERAL RECALL

Hell! If we're not going to do individual recalls, what makes you think we're going to do general ones?

12. THE FINISH

The finishing line, which is an imaginary line, but then, all lines are imaginary, will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the Race Committee boat and the nearby imaginary orange thing.

13. TIME LIMIT

There is no time limit for this race. You can sail all day or night if you wish. But the Race Committee is going in when it's ready for its nap. This modifies rule MMCXIV.

14. PROTESTS

- 14.1. Go ahead if you wish.
- 14.2. Fill out that damn form available at the office of the Houston Yacht Club and see if you can find someone to give it to.
- 14.3. Good luck!

15. SCORING

- 15.1 Scoring shall be in accordance with Appendix Z, except as modified here:
- 15.2 The Base 2-Point Scoring system, Appendix Z#!.## shall apply.
- 15.3 First place is awarded Π units, second place $\sqrt{2}$, third place 2.5, etc.
- 15.5 Ties will be broken. Just how is not known at this time.
