3rd ANNUAL RESCUE REGATTA

Notice of Race

Friday, July 25 – Saturday, July 26, 2025 In Support of Middlesex County Volunteer Rescue Squad Hosted By Fishing Bay Yacht Club

1. EVENT DESCRIPTION

- **1.1.** The RESCUE REGATTA is a Charity event to raise money for the Middlesex County Volunteer Rescue Squad. This Fundraising event will consist of a single pursuit, (staggered start), format race on July 26, 2025. The racing will be preceded by event registration, Skipper's Meeting, and a welcome happy hour on Friday evening at Fishing Bay Yacht Club. Saturday's race will then be followed by an evening of food, music and celebration at the Middlesex County Rescue Squad.
- **1.2.** The race will be open to PHRF (A, B, C, Cruising Spin & Cruising Non-Spin) sailboats holding a valid PHRF certificate or having a provisional handicap rating assigned by FBYC. CRUISING Non-Spin will be sailed allowing only one (1) headsail downwind.
- **1.3.** The format for all boats will be one short-distance, staggered start race around government marks.
- **1.4.** This Notice of Race (NOR) will constitute the complete NOR for this event unless updated on the event site on Regatta Network.

2. RULES

- **2.1.** The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2025-2028.
- **2.2.** All boats must meet US Sailing (Nearshore) Safety Equipment Requirements (SER) found at: https://www.ussailing.org/

2.3. If there is a conflict between a rule in the Notice of Race and one in the Sailing Instructions, the sailing instructions shall apply. This changes RRS 63.5(c)(2).

3. ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

- **3.1.** The 2025 Rescue Regatta is open to monohull sailboats holding a valid PHRF certificate or having a provisional handicap rating assigned by FBYC, racing under PHRF (A, B, C, Cruising-Spin & Cruising Non-Spin)
- **3.2.** Eligible boats may enter by completing the on-line entry and paying the required fees on the Regatta Network site for the Rescue Regatta. There will also be on-site check-in and payment. Race Registration must be completed by 1600, Friday, July 25, 2025.
- **3.3.** Online entries may also be completed in person at the Friday evening registration.

FEES

- **4.1.** The entry fee is as follows:
 - a. Early Bird Entry Fee = US\$120.00: Until Midnight, EDT, July 15, 2025
 - b. Entries After Midnight, EDT, July 15, 2024 = US\$130.00
- **4.2.** The entry fee includes:
 - a. Friday evening Welcome Happy Hour and Skipper's dinner, Saturday's Pursuit Race, Saturday evening celebration and Skipper's dinner, in-water storage from the start of registration until the end of the regatta.
- **4.3.** Additional dinner tickets will be available for purchase at online registration.
- **4.4.** Payment of all fees associated with each entry shall be paid at the time of registration. An entry will not be considered final until all fees are paid and all required forms are submitted.
- **4.5.** Checks should be made payable to "MCVRS Rescue Regatta"

6. ON-SITE INSPECTION AND MEASUREMENT

6.1 Boats and sails are subject to inspection.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

7.1 The final sailing instructions will be available at registration and posted online at the event Regatta Network site.

8. LAUNCHING AND MOORAGE

- **8.1.** All boats must be in the water by 0900 on the day racing begins. Late launching will require RC approval.
- **8.2** All boats shall remain in the water until the end of racing, unless granted prior permission by the Principal RaceOfficer.

9. COURSE

9.1 Course and Marks will be described in event Sailing Instructions.

10. SCORING

10.1 A boat's score will be the actual Finish Position in her designated Class and Overall.

11. PRIZES

11.1 Class awards for first, second, and third place will be presented at the Saturday Social Event.

12. COACH AND SUPPORT BOATS

12.1. All support boats are required to monitor the event's designated Race Committee VHF channel (72) when in the race course area and to immediately respond to race committee requests for assistance.

12.2. Any additional support boat instructions will be stated in the SIs.

13. INSURANCE

13.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$300,000 per incident or the equivalent.

14. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

14.1 Sailing is an activity that carries with it an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors participate in this regatta entirely at their own risk and are reminded to pay special attention to RRS 4, Decision to Race. The race organizers include the Organizing Authorities, Fishing Bay Yacht Club, Race Committee, Protest Committee, sponsors, volunteers, or any other affiliated organization or official who will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of practice for or participation in this event during shore side or on-the-water activities. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
