Eligibility: All entries must have a valid 2010 PHRF of the Chesapeake rating listed on the current valid list. PHRF category 4P requirements must be met.

Radio: Boats should monitor VHF 71 for courtesy communications from the race committee.

Start: Between an orange flag on TAYC balcony and an orange mark in the Tred Avon River.

Signals: RRS 26 (Starting Races):

Course: **Course 1:** Leave Choptank Area Mark "O" (Choptank River Light) to starboard, an offset Orange Tetrahedron will be placed next to Choptank River Light on the SE side and must also be left to starboard, Mark "D" (R"10") to port, government mark R"78" to port, government mark "CP" (off Taylor's Island) to starboard, government mark G"77" (near Cove Point) to starboard and return in opposite fashion, leaving government mark "CP" to port, R"78" to starboard, Mark "D" to starboard, and Area Mark "O" to port, Orange offset mark must be honored to port, and then to finish (57.2 nautical miles).

Course 2: Leave Choptank Area Mark O (Choptank River Light) to starboard, an offset Orange Tetrahedron will be placed next to Choptank River Light on the SE side and must also be left to starboard, Mark "D" (R"10") to port, round government mark R"78" to port, back to R"10" to starboard, to Choptank Area Mark O (Orange offset mark) to port and then to finish. (32.2 Nautical Miles)

COURSE CHANGE: Course may be shortened by eliminating a mark or marks, or at any mark of the course per RRS 32. Each yacht still racing must contact the yacht club at 1800 on VHF Channel 71 or via cell phone at 410.226.5269.

Finish: Between an orange flag on TAYC balcony and Choptank Area Mark "N" (R "2"). Yachts finishing after sundown SHALL illuminate their sail numbers for at least 30 seconds at the finish line. Yachts finishing after 2200 shall take their own time and report it immediately to TAYC at 410.226.5269.

Time Limit: No time limit.

Protests: Written protest must be delivered to the TAYC office within 24 hours of the last boat to finish. Protests heard as soon as possible after the race; time and location will be announced.

Awards: 1st/3, 2nd/5, 3rd/7+ finishers. Trophies will be presented or mailed as soon as practical.

Social: 0700-0830 – Coffee and doughnuts at TAYC.
1700-? – Cash Bar at TAYC and Light Fare. Bringing alcoholic beverages to and from the club premises is unlawful.

Other: If race is not shortened, it is requested that the first three boats to pass Choptank River Mark "R10" on the home leg, call the Club or Race Committee boat by VHF Channel 71, or cell phone at 410.226.5269 to report their approach.
