NOTICE OF RACE

Revision 1 changes noted in RED posted 6/10/2025

1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta shall be governed by the *Rules* as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 Yachts must have a 2025 PHRF Galveston Bay Racing Certificate.
- 1.3 A woman shall helm with an all-female crew **for the PHRF Spinnaker and Non-Spinnaker fleets**
- 1.4 **A woman shall helm with mixed crew allowed for the J24 fleet. Note: this fleet will not be eligible for the Fairfax Moody Regatta Perpetual Trophy.**
- 1.5 A male may provide verbal helming guidance to a woman helm classified ABSA B1, B2 or B3. A male safety officer will be allowed provided no guidance is extended to the crew.
- 1.6 There shall be a minimum of three crew.
- 1.7 Per the *Fairfax Moody Deed of Gift*, this regatta is only open to monohull sailboats.

2. FLEETS

PHRF Spinnaker, PHRF Non-Spinnaker **and J24**.

3. ENTRIES

- 3.1 Competitors shall enter online through Regatta Network or this link:

- 3.2 The Entry Fee is \$75. US Sailing members will receive a \$5 discount if they enter their US Sailing number during registration. Entries received after the Early Entry Deadline will be subject to a \$10 Late Fee. Partial entry fees will be refunded if the entry is withdrawn prior to the Early Entry deadline. See the Schedule, **NOR 10**.
- 3.3 NOTES:
The Fairfax Moody Regatta is part of a two-day women's sailing event. The Catherine Spiller Regatta on Sunday is a separate event and participants must register for each of these events separately on Regatta Network website.
Both Women's Regatta Weekend regattas are qualifiers for the 2025 Galveston Bay Women's Championship Series if registered in a spinnaker class. For details go to www.gbca.org.

4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available on Regatta Network by 12:00 pm on Friday June 20. No copies will be available at the Competitors Briefing.

5. NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

Notices will be posted on the Race Information Notice Board in the breezeway adjacent to the offices at Houston Yacht Club.

6. COURSES

- 6.1 The races will be Windward/Leeward courses with Rule 26 starts.

NOTICE OF RACE

- 6.2 The racing area will be held on upper Galveston Bay bounded by the Houston Ship Channel on the east, the Bayport Ship Channel on the south and the Shoreacres/La Porte shoreline on the west.

7. BERTHING

- 7.1 Yachts entering this regatta may be moored free of charge at Houston Yacht Club.
- 7.2 Prior to arrival, **boat owners must contact the HYC Harbor Manager at (281) 471-1255**
- a. Must provide an emergency contact number, and
 - b. Request slip availability.

8. TROPHIES

The Fairfax Moody Regatta Trophy will be awarded to the yacht with the lowest cumulative score of the Non-Spinnaker fleet. Trophies will be awarded at the HYC Porthole after racing.

9. SCORING

Scoring will be in accordance with Appendix 'A' Low Point scoring system of the RRS. No score will be excluded.

10. SCHEDULE

Friday, June 13, 5:00 pm Early Entry Deadline / Late fee applies thereafter.

Friday, June 20, 5:00 pm Regatta Entry Deadline

Saturday, June 21-Fairfax Moody Regatta

9:30 am Competitor's briefing at the Beachcomber

11:00 am Warning Signal for the first race, up to two additional races if weather and time permits.

After Racing Fairfax Moody trophy presentation followed by competitor's briefing for Catherine Spiller Regatta at the Porthole.

6:00 pm A light meal and a cash bar will be provided for competitors at the Porthole. Guest cards can be obtained by contacting HYC office before 4:30 pm.
