ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Based on event insurance requirements, all skippers must be a current member of the HCANA (Hobie Class Association of North America) regardless of the brand of beach cat.

Join with an annual membership of \$55 and you are ready to attend the many Hobie regattas that are now opening up to all brands of beach cats!

Personal Liability Insurance Required

All skippers are required to carry proof of personal liability insurance of \$100,000. Most homeowners and renter policies will cover personal liability, check with your agent to confirm. Download or print out a current declarations page to show our registration volunteers when you check-in at the regatta HQ.

CLASSES / EXPECTED CLASSES

Our 2025 regatta is open to all Hobie One-Design Classes as well as an Open Class!

We expect to have H16 A and H16B, WAVE Class starts, and an Open Class. Classes of 5 or more boats will get a start. Boats shall conform to class rules or have handicap certification. Classes with less than 5 boats registered may be combined into the Open Class.

DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. Sailing has inherent risk, see RRS 4, *Decision to Race*. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage, personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

BRING YOUR VHF RADIO

We encourage you to carry a personal VHF radio to monitor race committee communications and to declare an emergency or ask for assistance from the race committee. No Private Radio Communication Allowed. **Race Committee is on channel 69.**

You can easily store two cars and trailers per camp site, so sharing with fellow sailors is a great option.

YES YOU NEED A PASSPORT IN/OUT!

To enter Mexico, AND to reenter the United States, you will need to present a valid passport or passport card. All children under 16 (even infants) are required to have a passport. Be sure to plan ahead.

Every visitor entering Mexico must have an FMM form as well as a Passport or Passport Card. No application fee for trips less than 7 days. Regardless if you get the form at the Immigration Office or in Advance Online, you still need to stop and get it stamped at the Immigration Office just as you cross the border (building on the right hand side just passed the Mexican border gate).

PAPERWORK FOR YOUR BOAT!

If you register your boat in your home state, bring the registration paperwork! If your Hobie is not registered within your state, we highly recommend you register it before you attempt to bring it to Mexico. Be warned, a Bill of Sale for your Hobie may not be enough proof of ownership for the Mexican boarder official to let you cross into the country. Bring your current and up-to-date registration for boat and trailer, make sure it is in your own name. In past regattas, boats have been denied entry at the border for lack of proper paperwork showing ownership.

MEXICAN AUTO INSURANCE

If you are traveling into Mexico, you are required by law to have <u>Mexican</u> Automobile Insurance. Your US auto insurance liability policy, even if it bears a limited Mexican endorsement, is not recognized by Mexican authorities. **A separate Mexican Liability policy is required by Mexican Law**. Inexpensive Insurance can be purchased for the weekend at gas stations and insurance agents in **Gila Bend**, **Ajo**, **Why**, or **Lukeville**.

Having an auto accident in Mexico can be a felony, rather than a misdemeanor. Whenever you are involved in an automobile accident in Mexico, you must immediately be able to prove financial responsibility in either of two ways: 1) Immediate Cash to cover all damages OR 2) An approved Mexican insurance policy. All Citizens driving in Mexico are subject to the laws of Mexico.

ITEMS NOT ALLOWED INTO MEXICO

No firearms or ammunition into Mexico without prior written authorization from the Mexican authorities.

No duty-free alcohol. ALL alcoholic beverages - even on can of beer - must be declared and you will pay a 114% duty on whatever you bring. You are allowed nothing.... No 3 liters of alcohol and 6 liters of wine, no 6-packs ... Nothing duty-free. You can bring it, but you need to auto-declare and pay a 114% tax.

ITEMS NOT ALLOWED BACK INTO USA

All travelers entering the United States are required to DECLARE any meats, fruits, vegetables, plants, seeds, or animals. Most fruits, vegetables, and plants may not be brought into the United States. Fresh, dried, or canned meats and meat byproducts are prohibited entry into the US.
