5.0 Class Flags: The description of the Class Flags will be provided at the Competitors Briefing.

6.0 Courses:

- Race 1, Course 1: Saturday's (Out to east end of east Ship Island) first race is from a start line directly southwest of OSYC with the course continuing around Point Cadet and through Casino Row over to channel marker 12 (round to port) then out to the east end of east Ship Island. As sailors approach the island there is a visible Osprey Tower (30.254447 -88.869137) (not a mark of the course, simply a visual aid). The finish line is between RC Boat (blue flag) and orange tetrahedron (leave to port) will be to the west of the tower approximately one mile.
- Race 2, Course 2: Start East Ship Island RC Boat (orange line flag) and an orange cylinder (leave to starboard) Biloxi Channel #12 (Leave to starboard) Finish between RC Boat (blue flag) and an orange cylinder to starboard.
- Race 3, Course 3: Sunday (Round Deer Island): Start southwest of OSYC, start will be between RC Boat (orange flag) and an orange cylinder to port, then round Point Cadet continuing through Casino Row to the Biloxi Channel marker #12 (Leave to port) Biloxi Channel marker #2 (Leave to Port) Biloxi East Channel Marker #12 (Leave to Port) Finish between RC Boat (blue flag) and an orange cylinder to starboard


- Course 4: Start southwest of OSYC Biloxi Channel #12 (Leave to port) Biloxi Channel #2 (Leave to Port) Biloxi Channel #12 (Leave to starboard) Finish between RC Boat (blue flag) and an orange cylinder to starboard.
- Course 5: Start southwest of OSYC Biloxi East Channel #12 (Leave to Port) Finish between RC Boat (blue flag) and an orange cylinder to starboard.

Course 1: Ship Island Courses (Saturday).




Figure 2: Deer Island Course (Sunday)
