Flying Scot Southwest District and Dallas Corinthian Yacht Club cordially invite you to attend the Flying Scot Southwest District Championship and Circuit Stop #1 Regatta to be held May 29th-30th, 2010. This is a five race regatta with the option for a sixth race. This is the first regatta in the Flying Scot Southwest Circuit.

Rules: The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined by the 2009-2012 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and is designated Category A. The same crew must be used during the entire regatta. Substitutions can only be made with the written approval of the Protest Committee or Chief Judge. Sailing instructions will be distributed at registration.

Eligibility: Flying Scot Class yachts in compliance with class rules will be scored.

Location: The regatta will be held Dallas Corinthian Yacht Club.

Fees: The entry fee is \$65.00 for pre-registration and \$85 for late registration. To be eligible for pre-registration, a completed registration form must be received before midnight May 26th, 2010. To register, use the following link:

Scoring: Five races are scheduled of which one shall be completed to constitute a series.

Inspection & Measurements: All participants are subject to inspection and measurement at any time during the regatta. The Race Committee may, at its discretion, inspect any yacht in order to confirm compliance with the prescribed class rules concerning construction and measurements, safety rules when racing when racing.

Directions:

DO NOT SPEED DOWN YACHT CLUB ROAD! THE CITY OF OAK POINT POLICE WILL TICKET YOU.

From Lewisville - Denton:

Take I-35E, Stemmons Fwy E, US-77 and go Northwest for 10 miles
Bear right on ramp at sign reading "State School Rd. / Mayhill Rd."
Turn right at light after exiting and go approx. 1/2 mile
Turn right on Mayhill Rd. and continue to HWY 380
Turn Right on HWY 380 for 6 miles
Turn right on N Naylor Rd and go South for 2.5 miles to stop sign
Continue straight ahead on Yacht Club Rd and go South for 2.4 miles

From N DFW Airport:

At 114 / 121 continue on TX-121 and go Northeast for 14 miles
At The Colony turn left on FM-423 and go North for 7.4 miles
Bear left on E FM-720 and go West for 7 miles
Turn left on McCormick Rd and go West for 0.9 miles
Turn left on Yacht Club Rd and go South for 2.4 miles

From Geo. Bush 190

Take Dallas North Tollway and go North for 4.1 miles to Hwy 121
Cross Hwy 121 & continue on N Dallas Pky and go North for 5 miles
Turn left on Main St. in Frisco and go West for 4 miles to light at FM 423 merge
Turn right at light and continue taking the left fork at the 720 split for 8 miles
Turn left on McCormick Rd and go West for 0.9 miles
Turn left on Yacht Club Rd and go South for 2.4 miles
