SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Revision 1 changes in RED posted 12/30/25

1. RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, the Notice of Race and these Sailing Instructions.

2. ENTRIES

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all keelboats and multihulls **over 24' and beach cats**, all Clubs.
- 2.2 Classes will be: Handicap Non-Spinnaker, Handicap Spinnaker, Handicap Multihull **and SCHRS Beach Cats**.
- 2.3 Competitors to have either a PHRF-GB certificate or a HYC club rating assigned by the Race Committee **or SCHRS (Small Catamaran Handicap Rating System)**. (Note: this is a FUN regatta providing an opportunity for friendly competition and sailing to celebrate the start of the New Year)
- 2.4 Competitors must enter the event by registering online at <https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/29497> or at the Competitor's briefing at the HYC bar at 11:00. Online entry deadline is Wednesday December 31, 2025 at 18:00.

3. NOTICES TO COMPETITORS AND CHANGES IN SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Any Notices or Changes to SI's will be made orally at the Competitor's Briefing.

4. IDENTIFICATION

Each boat shall comply with the requirements of Appendix G and class rules with respect to class insignia and sail numbers.

5. SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

- 5.1 Any signals made ashore shall be displayed from the signal staff on the HYC lawn.
- 5.2 When flag AP is displayed ashore, "1 minute" is replaced with "not less than 60 minutes" under the "Race Signals" AP section (RRS).
- 5.3 Signal Flag "N" means the race is abandoned; no racing.

6. RACE SCHEDULE

One race will be sailed.

7. COURSES AND MARKS

- 7.1 The starting area will be at the leeward end of the course and the location will be announced at the Competitor's briefing.
- 7.2 The course will be 4 windward/leeward legs (2 laps) S-W-L-W-F, **no offset mark or gate**. Total course length to be shown in Attachment A – Starting Times. (Available at the Competitor's Briefing).
- 7.3 The windward and leeward marks will be yellow tetrahedrons.
- 7.4 The leeward mark will be approximately .05 nm to windward of the start/finish line and is not a part of the course for the 1st and 4th legs.
- 7.5 Boats shall not enter the Houston Ship Channel. The Houston Ship Channel shall rank as an obstruction.

8. THE START AND STARTING TIMES

- 8.1 The start line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the Race Committee signal boat and a nearby orange floating mark.
- 8.2 Individual start times **for the Handicap Non-Spinnaker, Handicap Spinnaker and Handicap Multihull** are distributed at the Competitor's briefing, Attachment A – Starting Times.
- 8.3 **Start time for the Beach Cats will be announced at the Competitor's briefing. This will not be a Rule 26 start.**
- 8.4 **In the event of a postponement, new starting times may be calculated by the race committee and communicated by VHF radio channel 68 or by voice hail. Competitors are responsible for requesting and verifying this information.**
- 8.5 A boat shall start not later than 10 minutes after her assigned starting time.
- 8.6 All start times are based on Official Time (GPS time). The Race Committee will monitor competitor start times and will attempt to identify OCS boats by hailing either their sail number or yacht name and display of signal flag "X". Failure of a boat to see or hear her recall notification will not be grounds for redress. This changes RRS **61.2**.

9. THE FINISH

The finish line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the Race Committee signal boat and a nearby orange floating mark, same as the start line. This changes RRS Race Signals.

10. TIME LIMIT

The time limit for the race is 150 minutes from the scratch start time of the first boat. Any boat finishing after this time will be considered as "did not finish" and will not be scored.

11. SAFETY

Any boat entered and then withdraws before finishing, shall notify the Race Committee by VHF radio channel 68 or, if that is not possible, the HYC office by telephone: 281-471-1255.

12. PENALTIES

A boat that takes a Two-Turns Penalty shall notify the Race Committee at the first reasonable opportunity after finishing.

13. PROTESTS

13.1 **This is an informal, fun event. Protests are discouraged.** Intent to protest shall be signaled in accordance with RRS, but competitors are strongly urged to take penalties on the water.

13.2 Notices to competitors will be posted on the Race Information Board (Official Notice Board) located in the breezeway adjacent to the HYC offices.

14. SCORING

14.1 Finish places will be determined by the order of finish **for the Handicap Non-Spinnaker, Handicap Spinnaker and Handicap Multihull.**

14.2 **Finish places for the Beach Cats will be calculated by SCHRS.**
