Practice Sail 12:30 PM	On-water safety coverage does not start until Saturday, but I encourage all new sailors to this event to participate in a casual practice sail around the island led by local sailors. If you'd like to join, be on the water at the National Park launching area and ready to sail <u>prior to 12:00 PM</u> . A casual dinner will be served afterwards at a location and time that will be shared that day.

Check-In 9:30-11:00	Sailors need to check-in on Saturday from 9:30 to 11:00 at 1729 Island Road, Harkers Island (George Evans' house). A laminated navigation chart, and a cap will be provided.							
Skipper's Meeting 11:45	A skipper's meeting will be held at the park service picnic shelter area at Shell Point.							
Racing 1:30 PM	The warning signal will sound at roughly 1:30PM. The start and finish line will be in the vicinity of Shell Point. The start will be between the race committee boat and a mark, then and sail through a gate of two marks. The finish line will be between the committee boat and a mark (color and shape to be announced in Sailing Instructions and at Skipper's Meeting).							

Appetizers & Dinner 5:30 PM	Sailors and their friends and family are invited to the fabulous Saturday dinner starting around 5:30pm at 112 East Drive, Harkers Island, NC 28531. Dinner includes appetizers, an entree, drinks (Dark & Stormys, beer, wine, and nonalcoholic beverages), and dessert (including a rum cake competition). Please register before July 15th. The later you register, the more likely we'll run out of what you want.					
	Entertainment includes screening of race videos and photos, including the traditional spectacular drone videos (weather permitting).					
Awards	An engraved perpetual trophy will be awarded to the Sunfish and Sol first-place finishers. Based or participation awards will also be given to the top 3 finishers in the racing class, and age ranges, top finisher in the beater class, top female, top youth (under age 19), and the winning rum cake chef.					
	ADDITIONAL INFORMATION					
Rules	The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (2025-2028)					
Safety	Sailors must wear water shoes and PFDs Sailors are reminded to review the Inland Rules of the Road governing navigation in restricted waters. Alcoholic beverages are not permitted on the National Park grounds or launching area.					
Parking & Unloading	Sailors should off-load Sunfish and gear onto the lawn near the registration table. Due to restricted parking space, please move vehicles (and trailers too large to fit onto the lawn) to the museum parking lot across Island Road as soon as possible to allow others access.					
Shoreside Activities	The launching site has a lawn with shaded picnic tables. Bathrooms are available near the picnic tables and at the Waterfowl Museum across the street. Bring a kite to fly, game to play or visit the Waterfowl Museum. Ferry service is available to visit the lighthouse at Cape Lookout National Seashore.					
Camping & Lodging	Tent camping is available on Harkers Island on the MOBYC grounds (1729 Island Road, a few houses up from the National Park launching site) and at the Harkers Island Sailing Club (1272 Island Road, with Sunfish beach launching area off Sunset Lane). The grounds will be open for campers starting Friday morning.

Directions	 From the Beaufort area: Follow Rt. 70 east to Harkers Island Road (gas station on right hand side, no traffic light, but there are signs). Turn right and follow Harkers Island Road over the new bridge onto Harkers Island (Harkers Island Road becomes Island Road once you are on the island). Follow Island Road almost to its end. The National Park launching area is on the right-hand side. The Waterfowl Museum (officially the Core Sound Waterfowl Museum and Heritage Center) is directly across the street at 1785 Island Rd.
