### 1 RULES

- 1.1 This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 Class rules apply.
- 1.3 RRS Appendix V (Alternative Penalties) applies unless amended by the Sailing Instructions.

## 3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The event is open to all Alerion 28 class boats.
- 3.2 Boats may enter the event by registering online by 1100 PST on April 10, 2025 at <a href="http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/29547">http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/29547</a>. To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees.

## 4 FEES

4.1 Entry fees are \$65

### 5 SCHEDULE

- 5.1 Three races are scheduled.
- 5.2 First warning will be at 1100.

## 6 RACING AREA AND COURSES

- 6.1 Racing will be in the area between Brooks Island and Southampton Shoal.
- 6.2 Marks will be temporary inflatable marks.

## 7 SCORING

7.1 Three races are scheduled. All scores will count towards the final score. This changes RRS A2.1.

# 8 AWARDS

8.1 Prizes will be awarded to the top three finishers. Awards to be held on the upstairs race desk as soon as possible after racing.

### 9 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILTY

9.1 RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.

10.1 Competitors are required to have valid third-party liability insurance.
