ELIGIBILITY: Regatta is open to all members of the FFCA in good standing at time of event.

RULES: The North American Championship will be governed by the rules as defined by "The Racing Rules of Sailing 2025-2028" including US Sailing prescriptions and the Class rules of the FFCA except those that may be modified by the Sailing Instructions.

<u>SAILING</u> INSTRUCTIONS; Sailing Instructions will be-posted on the TYC web site Race Page no later than May 20th.

COURSES: Courses will be determined by the Race Committee each race date, and will be displayed on the race committee vessel "Queen Merry". Marks are as stipulated on the Course Marks and Symbols Chart. Special Marks will be stipulated in the Sailing Instructions. The finish line shall be the same as the starting line unless the course is shortened or otherwise stipulated by the race committee when courses are determined.

SCORING: The High-Point Percentage Scoring System will be used in accordance with RRS Appendix A. For each race, the skipper will receive points equal to the number of boats beaten plus 1. To qualify for the series, a skipper must compete in at least 75% of the races in the series. The series percentage score will be calculated as the points earned divided by the total possible points for the races scored. Scoring may be modified at the discretion of a majority of the eligible Fleet 32 entered participants.

PRIZES: Series trophies will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place boats, **and for the combined Spring and Summer Series**??. Individual race results will be announced at the Clubhouse after each race. Trophies will be awarded at Skippers' Night.

RACE COMMITTEE DUTY; Each boat in the Series will volunteer to staff the Race Committee (RC) for at least one date during either the Spring or Summer Series. The skipper of record for the boat will report to the Rear Commodore or his representative no later than one hour before the first warning for RC duty. The boat assigned to RC will not participate in that race date but will be scored an average of its other series points for that race date.
