## 1. RULES:

This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the rules of the International Star Class Yacht Racing Association.

## 2. ELIGIBILITY:

Open to all boats and skippers that meet the requirements as listed by ISCYRA (STCR 21 and 26.4).

## 3. ENTRIES:

- Competitors are welcome to sail our Wednesday night race in the Miles River May 7<sup>th</sup> with a start time of 6 pm.

#### **6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:**

## 7. RACING AREA:

The primary race area will be the Miles River. If conditions dictate otherwise, racing may be held in Eastern Bay. The announcement of the race area will be made at the Skipper's meeting.

# 8. SCORING:

The low point scoring system of Appendix A (RRS) will apply. Three completed races will constitute a series. Each boat's series score shall be the total of the races scored. If four or more races are completed, then the worst race score shall be thrown out.

## 9. TROPHIES:

Trophies will be awarded to the first, second, and third-place finishers. The awards ceremony is scheduled for 3:30 p.m. on Sunday, following the last race.

# **10. LAUNCHING AND BERTHING:**

Hoist launching and dry storage in the Club field storage are included. Boat wash-down is only permitted at the wash-down area located in the MRYC boat storage field.

#### 11. SOCIAL:

<u>Breakfast</u>: A continental breakfast will be served Saturday and Sunday in the club lounge and is included in the registration fee.

<u>Saturday:</u> After racing, beer, sodas, and appetizers will be provided and is included in the registration fee.

Competitors are welcome to purchase dinner at MRYC, which is available from 5:30 to 9:00 pm each night.
