NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2025-2028 (RRS).

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1.1. The regatta is open to all members of Yacht Clubs and Sailing Associations recognized by US Sailing
- 2.1.2. Eligible boats may enter by registering on Regatta Network.
- 2.1.3. All entries must be submitted the day before each Regatta by 1700.
- 2.1.4. No Late entries will be accepted.

3. CLASSIFICATION

- 3.1. Class 1 – SD PHRF RLC 113 and Below.
- 3.2. Class 2 – SD PHRF RLC 114 and Above.
- 3.3. Class 3 – CYC Handicap: This can be found at the CYC website under the “Racing” tab:

- 3.4. Class 4 – 20’ and under with a PHRF rating no lower than 200. No CYC Class 3 ratings allowed, this will be your boats PHRF rating.

4. FEES

- 4.1. CYC Members are \$10, other Clubs are \$30.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 5.1. The sailing instructions will be posted on regatta network and available at the host Club by 10am of the race day.

6. VENUE and DATES

- 6.1. This course will be located in the San Diego Bay.
- 6.2. The Wellington Series
 - 6.2.1. April 12, 2025
 - 6.2.2. May 10th, 2025
 - 6.2.3. May 31, 2025

7. THE COURSES

- 7.1. Course(s) will be outlined in the SI’s. There might be different courses per class.

8. RADIO COMMUNICATION

8.1. Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. The SI's will discuss the radio channel for emergency communication.

9. PRIZES

9.1. This is a CYC race and Trophies are issued during the annual Trophy Presentation (TBD).

10.1. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
