

NOTICE OF RACE

I. RULES:

1. The regatta will be governed by rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.

II. Eligibility:

1. The regatta is open to all eligible boats of the following classes:

Optimist

Optimist Green

J 22

Formula 18 Cats

Club 420

PHRF (Spinnaker & Non-Spinnaker)

Laser (Standard Rig)

Laser (Radial Rig)

2. A minimum of 10 boats may be required for a One Design Start.
3. A minimum of 3 boats in a class may be required for a PHRF Start.

III. Registration:

1. Registration for this regatta can be completed on-line only at: www.hyannisyachtclub.org. Registration, as well as payment of appropriate fees, is to be completed no later than, Friday, July 23, 2010, at midnight. After July 23, 2010, an additional fee of \$50.00 will be added to each registration. This fee will not be waived. (See registration form for specific fees for each class.) **No refund of registration fees will be offered after July 23, 2010.**

2. No registrations will be accepted after Wednesday, July 28, 2010 at midnight.

3. All competitors under the age of 18 must complete and submit a Medical Form signed by a parent or Guardian prior to participation in the regatta. This form is available via the regatta registration website and may be faxed to (508-778-6811).

PHRF New England Certificates (2010) for PHRF registrants, with appropriate signatures, will also be required by check-in time.

4. No registration will be considered complete until all fees, required forms and signatures are received.

5. All pre-registered boats must check-in during the following hours to complete registration and obtain sailing instructions.

Check-in hours all classes:

Thursday, 7/29/10 1600-1900

Friday, 7/30/10 0800-1030

Saturday, 7/31/10 0730-0830 for Opti Green and PHRF classes only.

6. The number of boats in each of several classes has been limited. See the Registration Form located on the Hyannis Yacht Club website for details

7. Coaches with boats are requested to check-in with the Patrol Boat Volunteer desk.

IV. Advertising:

1. Hyannis Regatta is designated a “Club Event” in accordance with ISAF Regulation 20. Advertising is restricted to Category A.

V. Equipment:

1. All One design sailors are required to wear a US Coast Guard (or Canadian Coast Guard) approved PFD at all times while racing. One Design classes are subject to their class rules regarding required equipment.

2. ISAF Special regulations Category 4 applies to all PHRF classes. PHRF competitors are reminded of the US prescription to ISAF Special Regulations. “All personnel on deck shall wear personal flotation while starting and finishing, without exception and at all other times except when The Captain of the boat directs that it may be set aside.”

VI. Alternative Penalties:

1. One Design- the Two-Turns Penalty, RRS 44.2 will apply.

2. PHRF- the Scoring Penalty RRS 44.3 will apply.

VII. Scoring:

1. The Low Point Scoring System, Appendix A will apply, except that each boat’s score will be the sum of her scores for all races.

2. As many races as practical will be started during this regatta, however, in the event that only one race is completed, it shall constitute a series.

3. A boat racing with any sail number different from the number on its entry form may be scored “DNC” without a hearing. This changes RRS A5 and G4. A sail number may be changed on the entry form one (1) hour before the Harbor Start of any race day by notifying the Chief Scorer.

VIII. Sailing Instructions:

1. The Regatta Sailing Instructions and courses to be sailed will be available at registration. They may also be available on the Hyannis Yacht Club website.

IX. Racing Area:

1. Optimist Class- Lewis Bay, East of the channel
2. Laser Radials- Hyannis Port Harbor
3. Laser Standard- South of Hyannis Port Breakwater
4. 420's South of Hyannis Port Breakwater.
5. PHRF, J-22, Formula 18 Cats In the area between RN”4” Hodges Rock and Government Mark “HH”

X. Hyannis Harbor Channel Special Rule

1. The Sailing Instructions will contain specific instructions regarding transit to and from racing areas. These instructions must be followed by all competitors. Failure to follow these instructions will result in protest by the Race Committee and possible disqualification from the entire regatta.

XI. Prizes:

1. Prizes will be awarded as follows:

Additional Prizes:

Lasers (Standard Rig)	1 st prize, Master (over age 45)
	1 st prize, Junior (under age 18)
Laser (Radial Rig)	1 st prize, Junior (under age 18)
