

# 2025 USSCA Mid-Atlantic Championship Regatta #3 (WQ) October 4 – 5, 2025 Organizing Authority: Toms River Yacht Club Sanctioned by the United States Sunfish Class Association (USSCA) NOTICE OF RACE

# 1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The prescriptions of US Sailing will apply including Appendix V.
- 1.3 The rules and bylaws of the International Sunfish Class Association will apply. (Class Rules)
- 1.4 Under RRS 87, rule 1.3 may be changed in the sailing instructions or as posted on the official notice board.
- 1.5 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.
- 1.6 While on the water, each competitor is required to wear a USCG-approved personal Floatation Devise, except for brief periods while adding or removing clothing.

## 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Sunfish class, skippered by a registered member of the International Sunfish Class Association. Juniors must meet age requirements, ISCA rules.
- 2.2 Registration must be only. <u>https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/29769</u>
- 2.3 ISCA Rules decide entry to the **Sunfish World Championship Regatta.**
- 2.4 To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees by 2400 hours CST on September 30, 2025.

# 2.5 RISK STATEMENT

RRS 3 states: "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is his/hers alone" By participating in this event competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on

an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in an increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.

## 3. FEES

- 3.1 Registration fee is \$100.00. The registration fee includes a light breakfast, lunch and casual barbecue dinner on Saturday. Breakfast and lunch on Sunday. Complimentary keg after racing.
- 3.2 Registered entrants are requested to advise the Organizing Authority: Toms River Yacht Club, <u>tryc@tryc.comcastbiz.net</u> of their desired tee shirt size. Please provide a first choice and a second choice. Tee shirts will be provided on a first come, first served by event payment date. Size options are Adult Small, Medium, Large &Extra Large.
- 3.3 Competitor's spouses, family and supporters may attend the Saturday evening dinner buffet at 1800 hours for a fee of \$25.00

## 5. MEASUREMENT

Each boat and equipment must be compliant with current International Sunfish Class Association rules.

## 6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available online and at registration.

## 7. VENUE

The regatta will take place on the Toms River in front of the TRYC Club House or on the "Wanamaker Course" at the mouth of the Toms River.

## 8. THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be windward-leeward, triangles, or combination thereof. Courses may include an offset mark or gate as described in the Sailing Instructions.

## 9. PENALTY SYSTEM

US Sailing prescription V will apply.

## **10. SCORING**

- 10.1 One (1) race will constitute a regatta.
- 10.2 A maximum of seven (7) races will be sailed.
- 10.3 The Low Point Scoring System of RRS will apply with the following modifications: When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

When 5 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

## **11. BERTHING**

Boats shall be kept at the Toms River Yacht Club in an area assigned by the organizing authority. All boats must be at the regatta site by 0900 hours on Saturday October 4, and remain there for the duration of the Regatta, except with written permission of the Regatta Organizing Authority.

## **12. RADIO COMMUNICATION**

Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

## **13. PRIZES**

Prizes will be given as follows:

- a) Top 5 finishers
- b) Highest Place Female Finisher
- c) Highest Place Junior Finisher

### **14. CHANGES TO THE NOR**

The organizing authority retains the right to modify the NOR at any time. This will be posted on the event Regatta Network website notice board.

#### **15. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

#### **16. INSURANCE**

The Organizing Authority recommends that each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance.
