SANTANA 22 NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP

All entrants competing for the Santana 22 National Championship trophy are expected to be compliant with the following class rules:

- 1.5 Sailboat in compliance with the current Santana One Design Association (SODA) rules and in good standing with its fleet.
- 1.6 The skipper must be a current member of the Santana 22 Class Association.
- 1.7 All sails shall have a signed Royalty tag signifying that the sail meets class measurement requirements for one design racing. If sails require measurement, please contact Lindsey Presson (lpjrvt@gmail.com) to schedule a measurement appointment for Friday September 19.

J/24 DISTRICT 20 CHAMPIONSHIP

- 1.5 All owners must be members of District 20 good standing.
- 1.6 Class rule C.10.2 will be changed in the sailing instructions to H.2 Spare Spinnaker.
- 1.7 Class rule C.2.1(b) will be changed to H.4.3 A crew listed (*weighed in*) for this event may be different for different days **only** if scheduled in advance with the Regatta Chair by 1300 September 17th. Emergency changes may be made only with written permission of the race committee.

J/24 WESTERN REGIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP

For all entrants competing for the J/24 Western Regionals trophy and to be eligible for a J/24 2026 World Championship qualifying berth, the NOR is amended as follows:

1. RULES

- 1.5 All owners and helmspersons must be members of the USJCA.
- 1.6 Class rule H.2 Spare Spinnaker is in effect. This changes class rule C.10.2
- 1.7 Class rule C.2.1 (a) maximum crew weight is in effect. Declare full names and verify the total weight of all crew members participating during registration check-in. ~~Crew for this event shall remain the same throughout the event.~~ Class rule C.2.1(b) will be changed to H.4.3 A crew listed (*weighed in*) for this event may be different for different days **only** if scheduled in advance with the Regatta Chair by 1300 September 17th. Emergency changes may be made only with written permission of the race committee.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.3 Class rule A.10 is in effect. Owner and helmsperson must be USJCA class members and display their current class sticker on their boat.

ULTIMATE 20 PACIFIC COAST CHAMPIONSHIP

For all entrants competing for the Pacific Coast Championship Perpetual Trophy, the NOR is amended as follows:

- 1.5 The regatta is open to Ultimate 20 sailboats. Skippers must be current members of the Ultimate 20 Class Association and display their 2025 sticker on their boat.
- 1.6 All boats must be in compliance with the currently published Class One Design rules (OD-1 through OD-IX).
- 1.7 All boats must complete and submit an inspection form prior to sailing on Friday to document the presence of required equipment as stated in the current Class rules prior to racing. The inspection form must be countersigned by another member. All sails shall have a signed Royalty tag signifying that the sail meets class measurement requirements for one design racing.
