NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the current version of *The Racing Rules* of Sailing (2025-2028).
- 1.2 NAVAL and CRUISE SHIP PROTECTION ZONE: The Naval and Cruise Ship Protection Zone is a 500 yard regulated area of water surrounding all US Naval and Cruise Ship Vessels. All vessels within 500 yards of such vessel shall operate at the minimum speed necessary to maintain safe course and speed and shall proceed as directed by an official patrol. No vessel is allowed within 100 yards of Naval and Cruise Ship traffic
- 1.3 Sailboats sailing a similar course should take a conservative tactic to avoid any close quarter maneuvers to minimize collisions or prolonged entanglement.
- 1.4 All boats will carry an operational VHF radio (RC will listen and announce on Channel 69).
- 1.5 The course will be Random Leg as defined by PHRF. Classes 1 and 2 will use the PHRF ratings for RLC. Classes 1 and 2 may use a Spinnaker or use the Non Spinnaker Offset rating. Class 3 competitors will use Coronado Handicap ratings (no Spinnakers allowed).

2 ADVERTISING

2.1 Advertising is N/A for this regatta.

3 DELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all members of Yacht Clubs and Sailing Associations recognized by US Sailing.
- 3.2 The regatta is open to all classes [Class 1, Class 2, Class 3 (CYC Handicap)], that are in accordance with rule 3.1.
- 3.3 Eligible boats may enter by entering on Regatta Network:

- 3.4 All entries must be submitted by August 5 @ 1300 (1:00 PM).
- 3.5 No Late entries will be accepted.

7 VENUE

7.1 This race will start at Channel Marker SD 9. There will be an RC boat marking one end of the starting line.

8 THE COURSES

8.1 Course(s) will be outlined in the SI's. This race rounds the North Coronado Island to PORT. Finishing will be between SD 9 and SD 10 w/out an RC boat. Times will be texted or called in with a picture of the finish line.

9 RADIO COMMUNICATION

9.1 Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. CYC will be available on Channel 69.
