Corinthian Cup Saturday, July 19th & Sunday, July 20th

Marina del Rey & King Harbor, CA

Port Royal Yacht Club ("PRYC") and South Coast Corinthian Yacht Club ("SCCYC") cordially invite PHRF, Cruising boats, Dinghies and Predicted Log Racers to participate in the annual Corinthian Cup. A two day, two leg race between harbors, with a dinner layover at SCCYC between races. There is also a one day, one leg, race option.

1. RULES

- 1.1 This series will be governed by the *Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- 1.2 Any sailing Instructions on the mark charts DO NOT APPLY, and only the Corinthian Cup Sailing Instructions apply.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 Club membership is urged but not required. A current PHRF certificate is urged for PHRF classes but, not required. Boats without PHRF ratings will be assigned a rating by the RC
- 2.2 Entries should be filled out using online registration at <https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/29880> and will end at 1700 on Friday, July 18. Please note that registration is not complete until fees are paid.

3. FEES

- 3.1 The entry fee is \$50 for the two-day, two-leg series, or \$30 for one leg.
- 3.2 Dinner is \$15 paid separately to SCCYC. Please RSVP for dinner when registering for the event.

- 4. **VENUE:** The race area will be per the current SCCYC and KHYC Race Mark Guides, the Sailing Instructions and the Course Charts will be available online prior to Race Day.

5. CLASSES / CLASS FLAGS

- 5.1 Class splits will be determined no later than Friday July 18. It is anticipated that up to five classes will be established, of four general types: (A) Spinnaker, (B) Mariner/Non-Spinnaker, and (C) Dinghy and (D) Predicted Log racers.
- 5.2 The Race Committee reserves the option to assign entries to classes for competitive balance.
- 5.3 Class flags will be assigned in the Sailing Instructions.

7. **SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

Sailing Instructions will be available at <https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/29880> and both the SCCYC, PRYC websites no later than 2000 hours on Friday, July 18, the day prior to the race.

8. **COURSE / STARTING AREA for 2025**

- 8.1 Courses for each class will be specified in the Sailing Instructions.
- 8.2 Saturday, Leg One's course will be from King Harbor to Marina Del Rey, using existing marks in Santa Monica Bay. The start will be outside of the King Harbor breakwater in the vicinity of S Mark.
- 8.3 Sunday, Leg Two's course will be from Marina del Rey to King Harbor, using existing marks in Santa Monica Bay.
- 8.4 Leg Two, the start will be outside Marina Del Rey Harbor in the vicinity of SS mark.

9. **PENALTY SYSTEM:** Rule 44.1 is changed so that the one or two turn penalty is replaced by a one turn penalty. Rule 44.3 will not apply.

10. **SERIES SCORING**

There are two legs to the race, one leg each day. The corrected elapsed times will be used for scoring.

11. **TROPHIES**

Individual trophies for the series will be awarded at SCCYC at brunch held August 3, at 11:00am. . A name plate for the winner of each class will be added to the perpetual trophy.

Hospitality and Slips at PRYC

Parking: Gate codes for SCCYC and PRYC parking will be emailed to registered racers prior to the regatta.

Slips: PRYC does not have slips for overnight visitors. The City of Redondo Beach offers moorings in a field located in the southwest portion of the main harbor channel. Currently, daily mooring rates are as follows: 40' max: \$24.00; 50' max: \$30.00; 60' max: \$36.00. Requests for mooring space may be made in advance by calling the Redondo Beach Marina at (310) 374-3481 during normal business hours or by calling (310) 345-5676 during weekends or by hailing ch.5 on VHF radio. Vessel operators may also submit a reservation request online: Mooring Reservations – Redondo Beach Marina (rbmarina.com). Also, Port Royal Marina sometimes has available slips. It is best to call them directly at 310-376-0431 for pricing and availability. For those whose Clubs have reciprocals with KHYC, you can contact the KHYC Office at (310) 376-2459 to see if they have any complimentary guest slips available.

Breakfast: On Saturday, PRYC will be providing a complimentary breakfast buffet. Doors open at 0830 to 11:00.

Hospitality at SCCYC

Breakfast: On Sunday SCCYC will be providing a complimentary breakfast buffet. Doors open at 0830 for coffee, breakfast served from 0900 till 1100.
