# Marina del Rey & King Harbor, CA Sailing Instructions

Port Royal Yacht Club ("PRYC")) and South Coast Corinthian Yacht Club ("SCCYC") cordially invite PHRF, Cruising boats, and Predicted Log Racers to participate in the annual Corinthian Cup. A two day, two leg race between harbors, with a dinner layover at SCCYC between races. There is also a one day, one leg, race option.

# 1. RULES

- 1.1 This series will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 Any sailing Instructions on the mark charts DO NOT APPLY, and only the Corinthian Cup Sailing Instructions apply.

#### 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 Club membership is urged but not required.
- 2.2 A current PHRF certificate is urged for PHRF classes but not required. Boats without PHRF ratings will be assigned a rating by the Race Committee ("RC").
- 2.3 Entries should preferably be filled out using online registration at <a href="Regatta Network">Regatta Network</a> and will end at 0900 on Saturday, July 19th. Please note that registration is not complete until fees are paid.

#### 3 FFFS

3.1 The entry fee is \$50 for the two-day, two-leg series, or \$30 for one leg.

# 4. CLASSES / CLASS FLAGS

- 4.1 There will be three classes. The RC will group the races based on ratings, boat type and class size. A separate class might be designated based on the number and type of boats entered. Instructions for Predicted Log entrants are posted separately. There must be a minimum of 3 boats per class to race.

- 4.2 The Race Committee reserves the option to assign entries to classes for competitive balance.
- 4.3 Class splits will be posted by 18:00 on Friday July 18. Late entrants will be added to existing classes.
- 4.4 Class flags are the nautical flag. PHRF A is D flag, PHRF B is E flag, Cruising Non Spinnaker is R flag.

The RC will attempt to select courses that will take three hours to complete.

#### 6. NOTICES/COMMUNICATIONS

- 6.1 Amendments to the Sailing Instructions will be available at www.regattanetwork.com and at SCCYC,org sites no later than 2000 hours the day prior to the race leg.
- 6.2 Notices will also be sent via text message to entries that have provided for texting when registering for the race.
- 6.3 Notices might be given on the water.
- 6.4 Please monitor channel 69.
- 6.5 Please notify the RC via 69 of retirement.

## 7. COURSE / START / FINISH

- 7.1 Boats must check in each day they race.
- 7.2 The start will be a rolling 5-minute sequence. The order of starts is: PHRF A (D Flag), PHRF B (E Flag), Cruising (R Flag).
- 7.3 Saturday, Leg One, starting at the King Harbor S mark, will be from King Harbor to Marina del Rey, using existing marks in Santa Monica Bay. Finish line will be in the south entrance of the marina, a line between the navigation light on the south end of detached breakwater and an orange flag on the committee boat anchored in Ballona Creek.
- 7.4 Sunday, Leg Two, starting at MdR S mark, will be from Marina del Rey to King Harbor, using existing marks in Santa Monica Bay. Finishing inside King Harbor. Leave the Mid Chanel mark W to port and finish between orange flag on the Race Committee boat and the Redondo Beach East Jetty Light (#2) at the harbor entrance.
- 7.5 If there are no boats starting in a class, the start sequence for that class will be eliminated.
- 7.6 All marks are to be left to port unless indicated otherwise on the Corinthian Cup 2025 Course Chart by a red upper case "S".
- 7.7 If a mark is missing boats must round the GPS location of the missing mark.

## 8. **PROTESTS**

- 8.1 PENALTY SYSTEM: Rule 44.1 is changed so that the one or two turn penalty is replaced by a one turn penalty. Rule 44.3 will not apply.
- 8.2 Boats intending to protest or request redress must notify the Race Committee at the finish of the leg.

### 9. SERIES SCORING

The combined corrected elapsed times for the two legs will be used for scoring.

#### 10. TROPHIES

Individual trophies for the series will be awarded at SCCYC on August 3<sup>rd</sup>. A name plate for the winner of each class will be added to the perpetual trophy.
