Friday August 29, 2025

- 3:00 - 4:00 pm setup camp - Willow B & C Group campsites. Usually, the ranger at the guard shack will let us in around 12 - 1pm.
 - To reserve a camping spot in the group site contact Brett Bingham at 801-815-2521 or email him at usabrettbingham@hotmail.com. We only have 15 spots available for Fleet 67. So, book your site soon. Three nights camping fee and dinner for Skipper and Crew \$100.00. This will include ONE parking pass for camping for Labor Day weekend. If you are bringing an extra car there's parking outside the park that is available. This does not include your race fee.

 - Entry fee for the buoy racing for Skipper and Crew \$30.00 – If registering Friday night Cash or Checks only. We will be having three classes.
 - Three classes: one design Hobie 16, one design Hobie Wave, and open class. (Open Class all Boats will start together and will be scored with the **Portsmouth Rating system.**)

- The Standard Individual HCANA Membership fee is \$55 per year.

 - NOTE: HCANA is providing the million-dollar liability insurance that Utah State Parks requires to hold a Buoy Regatta

Rules:

1.0 - The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing*.

1.1 - Competitors shall wear US Coast Guard approved personal flotation devices

1.2 - The regatta is open to any catamaran sailboats that can be launched and recovered from the beach.

1.3 - Eligible boats may enter at the Regatta Entry Desk.

Classification:

2.0 - The following classification requirements will apply **US Sailing Portsmouth Rating**.

Sailing Instructions:

3.0 - The sailing instructions will be available on-line or a paper copy will be available at the registration desk.

Venue:


4.0 - Bear Lake State Park Rendezvous Beach

4.1 - Willow Group Campsites B & C - August 29th - September 1st

The Courses:

5.0 - The courses will be posted from the committee boat on the course board. The course will consist of A, B, C and starting mark. They will be placed based on the wind direction.

5.1 – The standard Hobie Class Association courses will be used. You can order a course sticker from the HCANA website <https://hcana.prepflag.com/product/hcana-course-sticker/>



Penalty System:

6.0 – Rule 44.1 has changed so that a Two-Turn Penalty is replaced by a One-Turn Penalty.

Scoring:

7.0 - The scoring system will be low point scoring for the series

7.1 – One Race is required to be completed to constitute a series

7.2 - Boats will be scored using US Sailing Portsmouth Rating System

Berthing:

8.0 - Boats shall be kept on the Beach

Prizes:

9.0 - Trophies will be given to the top three finishing boats after the Portsmouth handicaps have been calculated.

Disclaimer of Liability:

10 - Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury, or death sustained in the conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta

Safety:

11 - Sailors are strongly recommended to use trapeze harnesses with a quick release hookless system or a quick release hook, which meets the ISO 10862 standard

11.1 - All competitors must wear a USCG approved PFD while afloat during racing

11.2 - Sailors are encouraged to have a cell phone in waterproof case, sail knife, and adequate hydration for races.
