### NOTICE OF RACE

#### 1 RULES

- 1.1 The event will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing, together with the rules of the participating classes, the sailing instructions, and any additional sailing instructions to be issued at the competitors' meeting.

#### 2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 2.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available no later than one month prior to the event on the regatta website.

#### 3 COMMUNICATION

- 3.1 It is strongly suggested that all boats carry a VHF radio capable of communicating on all standard channels including but not limited to Channel 5.

#### 4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The event is open to all boats of the A-Cat, Albacore, Flying Scot, ILCA/Laser, Chesapeake 20, and Z420 classes.
- 4.2 Boats may enter the regatta by [registering online](#).
- 4.3 To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees.
- 4.4 A minimum of three(3) boats must be registered 10 days prior, May 28, 2025, to the event in order to guarantee a start for that fleet.

- 10.1** A chartered or loaned boat may carry national letters or a sail number in contravention of her class rules.

## **11 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

- 11.1** RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.

- 12.1** The bar will be open and dinner available after racing on Saturday. Dinner tickets can be bought through the regatta network page or via email (with payment on site).
