1. RULES:

1.1 The regatta is organized and hosted by the Mobile Yacht Club.

1.2 This regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the *2025-2028 Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS), the Regatta Sailing Instructions, the GYA Regulations for Sanctioned Events (available at www.gya.org), and applicable class rules. Appendix V will apply.

2. Eligibility:

2.1 The Regatta is open to all invited classes.

3. Invited CLASSES ENTRIES AND FEES:

3.6 No yacht club charge for fees.

4. NUMBER OF RACES:

4.1 Five (5) races are scheduled for GYA Capdevielle, Open Viper, Finn, and Fish classes of which one (1) race will constitute a regatta.

5. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS:

Saturday, July 12th

0900-1100 Regatta Registration and Check in
0900-1030 Free Continental Breakfast – Bar Will Be Open
1030-1130 Lunch Service Will Be Available – Sack lunches will be available for \$7.00
1100 Competitor's Meeting
1255 Warning signal first race of the day (races sailed back-to-back)
1600 Free Dinner & Entertainment will be provided for all participating in the Summer Regatta

Sunday, July 13h

0730-0900 Free Continental Breakfast – Bar Will Be Open
0855 Warning signal first race of the day (races sailed back-to-back) No starts after 1500.
Awards ceremony as soon possible following racing for all classes.

6. RACING AREA:

The racing area will be on Mobile Bay, East of MYC, North of Dog River Channel.

7. SAFETY and Disclaimer of Liability:

All boats shall comply with United States Coast Guard and State of Alabama safety equipment regulations. It is the responsibility of each skipper to determine if they should start a race or continue racing (RRS 3) or if wearing a life jacket is appropriate. This does not supersede any class rules or regulations that may require use of life jackets while on the water or racing.

8. SUPPORT BOATS:

As races will be sailed back-to-back, clubs are encouraged to provide support boats for crewchanges that may be required on the water.

9. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:

Sailing Instructions will be available at registration.

10. SCORING:

Each class shall be scored using the low point system of Appendix A with no races excluded. This changes RRS A2.1.
