SAILING INSTRUCTIONS - 2025 Summer Solstice Regatta

- I. RULES Races will be governed by the rules as defined in the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), except as amended by these instructions. These instructions may be modified at the competitor's meeting and posted in writing on the official notice board on the ground floor of the SSC clubhouse.
- II. ENTRY Each participant who registers with the race committee or who starts a race will be considered an entry.
- III. NOTICES TO COMPETITORS Notices to competitors will be posted on a board located on the ground floor of the SSC clubhouse.
- IV. COMPETITORS' MEETING Competitors' meeting will be held at 10:00 a.m. on the first day of the regatta.
- V. RACING AREA The racing area for portsmouth and one design classes will lie to the north and east of the SSC clubhouse and will not interfere with the Clear Creek Channel. Non Portsmouth fleets may be sent on longer courses.
- VI. COURSES The following courses may be sailed for one design and portsmouth. Should there be multiple class starts, the principle race officer (PRO) may choose FORMAT A and place the starting line downwind of the leeward mark and have a separate finishing boat and finish line situated upwind of the windward mark. The PRO reserves the right to use government daymarkers and other fixed marks, if necessary, for non-Portsmouth and non-one design classes. Be sure to attend the competitor's meeting.
