# NOTICE OF RACE

## King Kamehameha Offshore McFaul Beach Fleet

# June 21, 2025

### 1. RULES:

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing,* the prescriptions of US SAILING, pertinent Class/Fleet Rules, the Hawaii Yacht Racing Association Season Points Notice of Series, the Waikiki Yacht Club Standing Sailing Instructions, this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2. The Racing rules will be changed as follows:
  - 1.2.1.Rule 52 is changed to allow the use of powered winches for double-handed racers, single handed racers, and cruising class only
  - 1.2.2. Rule 52 is modified to allow the use of autopilot for doubled-handed racers, and single-handed racers only
  - 1.2.3. Rule 63.1 prescriptions are not in effect
- 2. ADVERTISING: Advertising will not be restricted.

### 3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY:

- 3.1. The regatta is open to all boats of the classes: X, A, B, Cruiser, Cal 20, and multihull with skippers who are members of HYRA member clubs.
- 3.2. Yachts will race and be scored if there are 3 or more entries
- 3.3. Eligible boats shall enter by registering on Regatta Network by the skippers meeting: Registration can be completed using the following link or QR Code the link

**FEES:** The entry fee up to 24hr of start will be \$65.00 for PHRF, \$25.00 for Cal 20s. Late registration (within 24hr of start): \$75.00 for PHRF and \$30 for Cal 20s.

### 4. SCHEDULE:

- 4.1. Regatta Network registration closes at 0000 HST on June 21, 2024
- 4.2. Skippers' Meeting: 0900 HST June 21, 2025
- 4.3. First Warning: 1055 HST July 21, 2025
- 4.4. Number of Races: All fleets will have up to three buoy races

- 5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: The Sailing Instructions will be available at the Skippers Meeting and on Regatta Network
- 6. VENUE: The Course Area will off the south shore of Oahu
- 7. **COURSES:** Courses will be displayed by the Race Committee at or prior to the warning of the race as described in the Sailing Instructions
- 8. SCORING: The scoring system is as follows:
  - 8.1. X, A, B, and Cruising will use PHRF Handicap rating systems as endorsed by HYRA
  - 8.2. Multi and Cal 20s will use The Low Point Scoring System
- 9. PRIZES: Prizes will be presented at the awards ceremony
