# HYANNIS YACHT CLUB ONE DESIGN SUMMER SERIES NOTICE OF RACE 2010

### THE HYANNIS YACHT CLUB IS THE ORGANIZING AUTHORITY 490 OCEAN STREET HYANNIS, MA. 02061

This Notice of Race is for the One Design 2010 Summer Series for June through September and Special Trophy Events listed on the schedule.

#### 1. Eligibility

These races are open to all Hyannis Yacht Club members and their sponsored guest with eligible boats of the following classes:

Optimist Club 420 Lasers (Standard or Radial Rig) J-22

#### 2. Decision to Race

Sailing is an activity that has inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in these events are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The race organizers (organizing authority, protest committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this event. By participating in these events, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation, to fullest extent permitted by law.

#### 3. Registration

Eligible boats must register online through the Hyannis Yacht Club Website www.hyannisyachtclub.org. A Medical Release Form is required for all competitors under the age of eighteen (18) years old. Medical Release Forms must be signed by a parent or legal guardian. Registration is not considered complete until all fees, forms, waivers and medical releases have been submitted.

#### 4. Rules

The One Design Summer Series and Special Trophy races will be governed by the rules as defined by *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

Advertising will restricted to Category A in accordance with ISAF regulation 20.

All One Design competitors are required to wear an approved Personal Flotation Device at all times while racing. *This Changes RRS 40* 

One Design Classes are subject to their class rules with the following exceptions:

J-22 class- No spinnaker may be used during the Thursday Series.

For all races the total maximum crew weight is 650 lbs.

Laser class- For the Sunday Series of races the Laser Radial Rig can be substituted for the Laser

Standard Rig. The substitution may only be made prior to the start of the days racing.

No subsequent substitutions will be allowed for that days racing. The Race Committee shall be notified of the substitution and any change of sail number

prior to the Class Warning signal.

#### 5. Penalty System:

For races conducted in Lewis Bay, a one turn penalty only including one tack and one gybe is required. *This changes RRS 44.1.* 

#### 6. Fees.

Required fees are as follows:

Optimist HYC member \$40.00 Non-member \$120.00

Club 420 HYC Member \$75.00 Non-member \$225.00

Laser HYC Member \$75.00 Non-member \$225.00

(Standard or Radial rig)

J-22 HYC Member \$100.00 Non-member \$300.00

#### 7. Schedule.

Thursday Series: Three separate series, June, July and August

Location: Lewis Bay Classes J-22 and Laser Warning 1800

Two separate series, July and August

Location: Lewis Bay Club 420 Class Warning 1800

Sunday Series: Two separate series, July and August

Location: Lewis Bay Classes Optimist and Laser Warning 1200

Two separate series, June and September

Location: Lewis Bay Classes J-22 and Laser Warning 1000

Two separate series, July and August

Location: South of the Hyannisport Breakwater

J-22 Class Warning 1300

**Special Trophy Races**-See last page of Complete 2010 One Design Schedule.

At the discretion of the Race Committee, a minimum of three (3) boats in the same class may be required for a start.

#### 8. Scoring.

Appendix A, The Low Point System will apply with the following. A boat's worst score will be discarded every five (5) races it completes.

#### **Commodores Cup Series**

J-22 Class boats competing in both the July and August Series, are allowed a total of three drops for the purposes of calculating the Commodores Cup standings.

#### 9. Sailing Instructions.

Sailing Instructions will be available prior to the first race at the HYC Race Committee Office or on the HYC Website.

Courses will be described in the Sailing Instructions.

#### 10. Prizes

Prizes will be awarded as follows for each series as described in the schedule.

3 boats 1<sup>st</sup> Place

5 boats 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Place 6 or more boats 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Place

There may be periodic recognition given for daily results.

**Commodores Cup**-The Commodores Cup will be awarded to the J-22, Laser and Optimist Class boats with the lowest point score for the combined results of the July and August Sunday series .

Special Trophy Events-One prize will be awarded.

#### **GOOD SPORTSMANSHIP**

The Hyannis Yacht Club encourages good sportsmanship. A fundamental principle of sportsmanship is that when competitors break a rule they will promptly take a penalty or retire. The basic principle is often described as Corinthian. Good sportsmanship is expected of all our competitors. Foul and abusive language on the race course by any member of a crew may result in a protest by the Race Committee and disqualification from an entire series.
