Special Notice for CRA Commodore's Cup Raft-Up 2025

Raft-up and Crew Transportation:


- Koehler Kraft's beautiful blue and white 63' trawler, the *Dickie Walker*, will be the hub of the raft up in Mariner's Basin. CF Koehler will anchor in the vicinity of the entrance to Mariner's Basin, closer to the crew pick-up point and away from the shallows. The raft will need to break up by 9:30am Sunday morning. Please plan accordingly.
- Crew transportation is ultimately your own responsibility, but we will have a few options to assist you. There will be at least two small boats ready to scoot around to deliver people from one place to another on Saturday. Rod Messinger's Buttercup, a Schock 35, will be the biggest people mover in operation. A big "thank you" to Rod! Buttercup will handle crew transportation en masse and will operate between the raft-up and the Public Reception Dock in Quivira Basin. Crew parking there will require a short walk and parking is not guaranteed. Please see below for a map of that area.
- Other transportation needs, for example, to go ashore in Mariners Basin, will need to be supplied by the skipper.
- Crew pick-up Sunday morning: Buttercup will take two loads of passengers Sunday morning. The first group will go at 8:30am, and the second group will go at 9:00am.
 Please inform your crew to be ready at the Public Reception Dock at those times and they will be transported. Parking on Hospitality Point should be easier in early morning.
 Again, please see below for a map of that area.
- The Public Reception Dock is also available for skippers to drop off and pick up crew themselves. Another alternative for individual skippers and crew is the fuel dock at the Hyatt Regency Mission Bay, also located in Quivira Basin.
