- 3. You will inform the Categorization Authority (and any relevant organising authority) as soon as possible of any incorrect information in this application (or any changes in your circumstances) which might affect your categorization and in any event no later than the first race of any particular event.
- 4. You agree that the Categorization Authority may seek any information it needs from any source at any time to verify your categorization without further recourse to you.
- 5. The Categorization Authority does not accept any liability for any losses, expenses or damages incurred by a Competitor as a result of the Categorization Authority exercising its powers under the Code in good faith.

#### **Obligations**
