### **RULES, ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY:**

- A. Races are open to ILCA 7 and ILCA 6 (Standard, Radial) Rigs.
- B. The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of US Sailing, the rules of the International Laser Class Association (ILCA), this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.

### **FEES:**

- A. Entrance fee is \$25 and includes light breakfast, post sailing snacks and beverages (draft beer/soft drinks) at the conclusion of the day's racing and prizes.

### **REGISTRATION:**

- A. Registration is **online only** through Regatta Network

  - b. Payment is required to complete registration
  - c. \$2.50 non-refundable deposit
- B. Sailing Instructions will be available no later than check-in on the day of the event

### **SCHEDULE:**

**September 28:** 0830 - 0930 Check in  
1000 Skippers' meeting  
1045 First Warning Signal  
No warning signal after 1500  
1600 Post-race refreshments and Awards

There are 6 races planned. One race constitutes a series. If 6 races are completed there will be one throw-out race.

**COURSES:**

- A. Courses will be windward/leeward, triangle or Olympic courses that may include an offset mark and a gate, as described in the sailing instructions.

**SUPPORT BOATS:**

- A. All coach and spectator boats must remain 75 yards from the course area unless asked to help by the race committee.

**AWARDS:**

- A. Awards will be presented for places 1-3 in the overall fleet.
- B. The winner will have their name added to an RYC perpetual trophy.
- C. There will be an award for the top finishing radial.
- D. Awards will be presented at the conclusion of racing.

**RISK:**

Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3, Decision to Race. The race organizers (organizing authority), race committee, protest committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this event. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
