

Hello Sailors, Parents & Coaches,

As we approach the Pirates of The Corinthian event at DCYC this weekend, I wanted to share some key details to help you prepare for a great experience.

Gate Access and Boat Arrival

The club gate will be open starting at 1:00 PM on Friday and will remain open until midnight. It will reopen at 6:00 AM on Saturday morning. You are welcome to bring boats to the club at any time starting Thursday evening. When you arrive when the gate is closed, please call or text me for access.

Camping and Accommodations

We are fortunate to have a wonderful facility for camping, and we encourage families to take advantage of this option. The clubhouse has full bathroom and shower facilities available to all. RVs and campers are welcome; however, please note that power hookups are limited and will be provided on a first come, first serve basis. If you would like to bring RVs early to avoid crowds, please contact me for gate access. Additionally, there are several hotels and Airbnb's near the club. A list of these accommodations is available on the Pirates page in Regatta Network.

Boat Launch Procedures

You may launch coach or parents' boats at any time before or after the sailors' launch. However, no boats are permitted to launch while sailors are departing or entering the harbor. Ancillary boats can be parked in available slips as needed.

Meals and Registration

All meals are included with sailor registration. Additional meals may be purchased during open registration. Please note that both food and T-shirts will be available in limited quantities at the registration desk after registration closes.

- Breakfast: Breakfast tacos, granola bars, and fruit
- Saturday Lunch: Jersey Mikes sandwiches, chips, and a cookie
- Saturday Dinner: Brisket, pork, chicken, assorted sides, and ice cream for dessert
- Sunday Lunch: Burgers and hot dogs, chips, and dessert

Additional Information

Dogs are welcome at the club but must remain on a leash. As DCYC is a BYOB club, you are invited to bring your own adult beverages.

Activities and Entertainment

After the races, enjoy several lawn games such as volleyball, horseshoes, lawn golf, and likely a game of pickleball on Saturday night. If you wish to participate, feel free to bring your own equipment and join in.
