Additional Information

DIYC Pet Policy

All domestic animals (except for animals trained to assist a physically impaired person) are prohibited from inside the clubhouse, on the upper porch and in pool area. Dogs must be leashed, with their owner, not on chairs or tables, and owners shall clean up after their pets.

Trash / Recycling Policy

DIYC is a Clean Marina and we are committed to an environmentally friendly organization on Tampa Bay. Proper recycling is an important initiative for our community and our club. We pay a premium to have our recycling material disposed of properly. Please dispose of acceptable recycled material ONLY in the **GREEN CANS** located at the end of the Docks. Acceptable items are clearly marked on each can. Please **DO NOT PLACE PLASTIC BAGS IN THE RECYCLING CANS**.

House Rule 15

- 15. Temporary use of Wet slips or mooring at end of "A" dock, Dry slips or other slip areas is limited to Florida Council of Yacht Club (including DIYC) members and transient members of other organized yacht clubs providing they have proper Yacht Club identification. Non-yacht club members may be accepted while participating in DIYC sanctioned Regattas or other specified events. Charges for electrical facilities from and including day one will be \$3.00 per day for single 30 amp service or \$6.00 per day for either a double 30 amp service or a single 50 amp 220 volt service.
 - a. Temporary dockage or Dry slip occupancy is limited to 2 weeks duration with prior approval of the Dockmaster as specified for in Rule 6, paragraph 2.
 - b. Other than electricity needs, Wet or Dry slip dockage will be at no charge for two days prior and two days following specified regatta or Club sanctioned event. Beyond that, Wet slip mooring charges will be \$1.00 per foot per day and Dry slip charges will be \$.25 per foot per day, plus electricity. Specific one-day events, similar but not limited to, Thursday Night races and Sunday races do not constitute an event that will provide the no charge four day dockage.
 - c. There will be no charge only on the first day of dockage or Dry slip occupancy in absence of specified regattas or Club sanctioned events.
 - d. A copy of the rules or some specific reference to this rule shall be included in all race entry forms. All visiting skippers shall be responsible for the conduct of their non-member crew and liable for any actions or damages which occurred while on Club property. The visiting skippers and their non-member guests may be brought before the Board and sanctioned by the Board of Directors.
