## NOTICE OF RACE Saturday, November 15, 2025

**Organizing Authority:** The organizing authority is the Halifax Sailing Association (HSA), 15 Fremont Court, Daytona Beach, FL 32114.

Rules: This regatta is governed by the Rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

**Expected Classes**: Sunfish, Laser, RS Aero, Capri 14s, 420s, FJs, Wetas, and multihulls. A youth division will be sailed in Optis in two fleets—Green and Red/White/Blue.

**Entry and Eligibility:** This Regatta is open to the above-mentioned One-Design classes, as well as multihull boats with US Sailing Portsmouth ratings. To have a One Design division, three or more paid entries in a class type are required by November 8<sup>th</sup>, 2025. Completion of the entry form and liability waiver is required to compete. Since this is a non-sanctioned regatta, the Sunfish class will allow class-legal and non-class-legal Sunfish to race together.

**Entry fees:** Registration is available on Regatta Network <u>www.RegattaNetwork.com</u> and onsite the morning of the regatta.

Adult Multi-Crew: \$75 (includes two meals) Singlehanded: \$60 (includes one meal)

College & Youth Sailors: \$25 (includes one meal)

Day of Regatta Registration: Add \$25 late fee/registration, so register early!

Additional meals: \$15 each (Please order by 11/8/2025).
