A. Rules

The regatta will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing

B. Eligibility and Entry

The regatta is open to all boats. Expected classes may include SJ 21, Catalina 22, Flying Scots, Windmills, Lightnings, Lasers, Sunfish, and Open Portsmouth using D-pn rating. 5 paid entries of the same make and model will constitute a class. One completed race constitutes a regatta. Fleet assignments and starts may be adjusted at the discretion of the Race Committee. Eligible boats may enter the Regatta by completing the registration and paying fees on Regatta Network online at [Regatta Network](#). Failure to complete payment in advance will be regarded as a late registration at the listed fee.

C. Fees

Before November 1- \$100.00 - includes 2 meal tickets

After November 1- Late Registration, \$120.00

Single handed boat - \$10 Discount with one meal ticket

US Sailing member discount with ID card \$5.00

Additional meal tickets \$15.00

E. Venue

The Regatta will be held on Lake Monroe, Sanford Florida. Regatta Headquarters will be the LMSA Clubhouse.

F. Sailing Instructions

Sailing Instruction will consist of the SIs provided in Appendix S of the RRS, Standard Sailing Instructions. Any additional instructions will be Posted on the Notice Board located outside the LMSA Clubhouse.

G. Communication

The official Notice Board will be located outside the LMSA Clubhouse. Competitors will use VHF Channel 69 for on the water communication. No outside communication not available to all boats in the regatta are permitted. This includes radios and cell phones.

H. Schedule of Races

3 races are scheduled for Saturday

2 races are scheduled for Sunday

The Race Committee may alter the number of races per day at their discretion.

I. Scoring

Appendix A of the RRS will be applied to the Regatta. All races will be Included. One completed race will constitute a Regatta.

J. Race conduct

Class flags will be posted on the Notice Board and discussed at the skippers meeting

Race courses will be posted on the Notice Board.

Official mark and safety boats will be identified at the skippers meeting.

K. Risk Statement

RRS sailing rule #3 applies. The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in or continue in a race is hers alone. A release of liability form must be signed for each boat in the Regatta.

L. Prizes

Trophies will be awarded to the top 3 finishers in each defined class.
