

**Performance Regattas Foiling Shootout**  
**November 14-16, 2025**

**Notice of Race**

**1 RULES**

The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2025-2028 and Performance Regattas, the Organizing Authority.

**2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

2.1 The regatta is open to all sailors.

2.2 To be considered an entry in the event, a team shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees either online or in person by November 12, 2025.

2.3 The following restrictions on the number of boats apply. The event will be limited to 15 teams.

**3 FEES**

3.1 Entry fee: \$500 per all-male team  
\$250 for mixed or all-female team

3.2 Entry fee includes boat charter, liability insurance, t-shirt, helmet, and social events for skipper and crew.

**4 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

Sailing Instructions will be available at check-in and during the daily competitors meeting.

**5 VENUE AND COURSES**

5.1 Tampa Bay just north of Davis Island Yacht Club will be the racing area.

5.2 Races will be sailed on a Performance Regattas Race Track as described in the Sailing Instructions.

**6 SCORING**

6.1 Format: The regatta will consist of multiple stages:

6.1.1 Round Robin(s): Each team will race against other teams at least once.

6.1.2 Quarterfinals: Top 9 teams from the round robin(s) will advance.

6.1.3 Semifinals: The top 6 teams from the quarterfinals will advance.

6.1.4 Finals: The top 3 teams will race for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place.

6.1.5 Abandoned Matches: The Race Committee reserves the right to adjust the format if weather or time constraints limit the number of races completed.

**6.2 Match Scoring**

Each win earns 1 point.

Second place scores 2 points.

Third place scores 3 points.

A bye (if applicable) scores 3 points.

### 6.3 Tiebreakers

In the event of a tie between two or more teams based on points at the end of a round:

Number of points from previous rounds will be added.

Head-to-head results between tied teams.

Total number of wins.

Total number of seconds

Number of penalties (fewer is better).

If still tied, the Race Committee may conduct a sail-off or draw lots.
