

# Notice of Race Jeff Penfield Memorial Regatta Flying Scot Class – November 15-16, 2024

#### 1. Organizing Authority

1.1 The organizing authority of the regatta is the Sarasota Sailing Squadron

#### 2. Rules

- 2.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing
- 2.2 Racing Rule A2.1 will be changed as follows: No race scores shall be excluded
- 2.3 The Sailing Instructions will consist of the instructions in RRS Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions, and supplementary sailing instructions which shall be on the Official Notice Board located in the gazebo adjacent to the clubhouse.

# 3. Eligibility and Entry

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Flying Scot Class with current membership.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by registering on regattanetwork.com
- 3.3 The fee is \$65 per boat which includes the Cookout dinner Saturday evening.

#### 4. Schedule

4.1 Five (5) races are scheduled. A maximum of 3 races will be sailed in one day. One race shall constitute a series.
