## NOTICE OF RACE

# Wahine Big Boat Pau Regatta October 18, 2025

#### 1. RULES:

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, the prescriptions of US SAILING, pertinent Class/Fleet Rules, the Hawaii Yacht Racing Association Season Points Notice of Series, the Waikiki Yacht Club Standing Sailing Instructions, this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2. The Racing rules will be changed as follows:
  - 1.2.1.Rule 52 is changed to allow the use of powered winches for double-handed racers, single handed racers, and cruising class only
  - 1.2.2. Rule 52 is modified to allow the use of autopilot for doubled-handed racers, and single-handed racers only
  - 1.2.3. Rule 63.1 prescriptions are not in effect
- 1.3. A female must be at the helm from the warning signal to the finish of each race. If a male touches the helm during this time, the yacht shall retire from that race. Crew shall be at least 50% female, (rounded up for odd number crews). More females are preferred but not required. Females are expected to have key roles. The skipper (not crew) shall be a member in good standing of any HYRA member club in order to be eligible for the North Sails Wahine Skipper of the Year Trophy.
- 2. ADVERTISING: Advertising will not be restricted.

## 3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY:

- 3.1. This event is open to monohull keel boats of 21 feet or more. Boats shall be owned or chartered by a member of WYC of a HYRA affiliated organization.
- 3.2. Yachts will start and be scored together.
- 3.3. Eligible boats shall enter by registering on Regatta Network by the skippers meeting: Registration can be completed using the following link or QR Code the link

FEES: The entry fee is \$45 dollars (\$5 goes towards the Wahine Sailing Series)

## 4. SCHEDULE:

- 4.1. Regatta Network registration closes at 1000 HST on October 18, 2025
- 4.2. Skippers' Meeting: 1000 HST October 18, 2025

- 4.3. First Warning: 1155 HST October 18, 2025
- 4.4. Number of Races: The fleet will have three races
  - 4.4.1. 4<sup>th</sup> race of the day fun race for alternate helmswomen may be held as determined by race committee and skipper's meeting. Race will not be scored.
- 5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: The Sailing Instructions will be available at the Skippers Meeting and on Regatta Network
- 6. VENUE: The Course Area will off the south shore of Oahu
- 7. **COURSES:** Courses will be displayed by the Race Committee at or prior to the warning of the race as described in the Sailing Instructions
- **8. SCORING:** The scoring system is as follows:
  - 8.1. All classes will use PHRF Handicap rating systems as endorsed by HYRA and be scored together
- 9. PRIZES: Prizes will be presented at the awards ceremony
