NOTICE OF RACE

1 Rules

The Regatta will be governed by the Rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.

RRS Rule 40: Personal Flotation Devices.

“Y” flag will not be flown. This changes RRS Rule 40.2

2 Eligibility & Entry

The Regatta is open to centerboard, multi-hull and keel boats. One design fleets with greater than four entries may be given a one-design start.

Competitors may enter in advance by completing the Event Registration Form found on <http://www.regattanetwork.com>, click on calendar and go to Regatta List to find the Whiskeytown Memorial Weekend Regatta.

Competitors may also enter by completing an Entry Form available on <http://www.whiskeytowsailing.org> under the “Regatta” tab and delivering it by 0830, Saturday, May 23, 2026.

3 Fees

The fee to race in the Whiskeytown Memorial Weekend Regatta is \$65.00. Early entries received by May 1st may take a \$10 discount. US Sailing members receive a \$5.00 discount.

5 Sailing Instructions

Sailing Instructions will be available after 1200 hours, Friday, May 22, 2026, at the Regatta Headquarters at Brandy Creek Marina. Instructions will also be available on the Whiskeytown Sailing Club website, www.whiskeytowsailing.org on or before May 22, 2026.

6 Venue

The racing area shall be the main body of water of Whiskeytown Lake. A detailed map is available at www.whiskeytownsailing.org under the "Regatta" tab.

7 Courses

The diagram in Attachment "A" of the Sailing Instructions shows the location of the racing area, and the courses, the order in which marks are to be passed, and the side on which each mark is to be left.

The courses to be sailed will be displayed from the Race Committee Signal Barge.

The marks shall be white cylindrical floats bearing a number corresponding to the course chart. Marks "A", "B" and "C" will be orange cylindrical marks.

8 Penalty System

The RRS Appendix "V" shall apply.

9 Berthing

10 Launching

A launch ramp is available at Brandy Creek Marina

11 Scoring

One race is required to constitute a regatta. When 6 races are completed a boat's series score will be the total of her races scored excluding her worst score. If fewer than 6 races are completed a boat's series score will be the total of her races. This changes RRS A2.

12 Prizes

Three trophies shall be awarded for each class.

13 Decision to Race

The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone. RRS 3.

14 Acknowledgement of Risk I agree to abide by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS). I certify that I am fully capable of participating in this activity. Therefore, I assume and accept full responsibility for myself, including all minor children in my care, custody, and control, and all competitors on my boat, for bodily injury, death, damage or loss of personal property and expenses as a result of those inherent risks and dangers (see RRS3, Decision to Race) and those inherent risks and dangers not specifically identified, and as a result of my negligence in participating in this activity.

15 Insurance

All competitors shall maintain marine liability insurance throughout the regatta.

16 Photography

I understand that Whiskeytown Sailing Club members and/or their associates will photograph boats sailing in the regatta, and that photos which include my boat may be used in future promotional materials.
