



2026 Weekend Racing Notice of Race

The Fort Worth Boat Club as the Organizing Authority (OA) cordially invites you to the 2025 Weekend Series comprising the Marigail, Roadie, Rolling Time, Hub Isaacks, PAKI and Blue Moon on Eagle Mountain Lake.

1. Rules

1.1 The Series will be governed by the rules defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2025-2028, the class rules of the applicable one design classes, and the FWBC Performance Handicap Racing Fleet (PHRF) Rules and Regulations. The J22 FWBC Fleet Rules will also apply for the use of the club owned J22 fleet.

2. Eligibility & Entry

2.1 All series are open to keelboats with a valid PHRF rating on file with the FWBC Office.

2.2 Eligible boats may register for the series at the Fort Worth Boat Club website at <https://www.fortworthboatclub.com/club-racing>

3. Classification

3.1 Spinnaker classes are allowed to use spinnakers while racing.

3.2 Genoa classes shall not use spinnakers of any kind while racing.

3.3 One design boats participating under class rules will be scored as a fleet, with a minimum of 3 boats registered for the series.

3.4 Fleet assignments are defined in the Sailing Instructions for PHRF ratings.

4. Fees

4.1 The entry fee for the Weekend Series will be:

Annual Pass for All Series - automatically entered for each series is \$225.00

Series Pass entered for a series will be \$50.00

4.2 Entry fees will be charged to the account of the registered Skipper/Owner

4.3 Entry fees are non refundable.

5. Schedule

- 5.1 The scheduled race days and number of races are listed in Appendix A.
- 5.2 The first warning signal will be on Sunday's @ 2.00 pm for the Marigail, Roadie, Hub Isaaks, Paki and Blue Moon. The Rolling Time series first warning signal will be on Saturday's @ 10.00 a.m.
- 5.3 The awards for a series will be presented after the next scheduled race of the following series.
- 5.4 PRO assignments are listed in Appendix A, attached to this document.

6. Sailing Instructions

- 6.1 The Sailing Instructions are based on Appendix S Standard Sailing Instructions as defined in the RRS 2025 - 2028 with local amendments, these <https://www.fortworthboatclub.com/club-racing>

7. The Courses

- 7.1 The courses to be sailed will be windward - leeward, triangle, olympic or combinations thereof.
- 7.2 The course to be sailed will be indicated by the Race Committee prior to the warning signal.

8. Scoring

- 8.1 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 8.2 When five races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- 8.3 When six races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.
- 8.4. When nine races have been completed, a boat's series scores will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

9. Radio Communications

- 9.1. Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. 9.2. Communications from the race committee or signal boat will be on Channel 68.

10. Prizes

- 10.1. It is a goal of the Race Committee to encourage consistent race participation in addition to performance. As such, prizes will only be awarded to boats that participate in at least 60% of the completed races in a series.
- 10.2. Prizes will be awarded at the discretion of the Race Committee based on participation levels.

11. Disclaimer of Liability

11.1. Sailing is an activity with inherent risks of damage and injury. Competitors in this event participate entirely at their own risk – see RRS 3, DECISION TO RACE. The race organizers (Fort Worth Boat Club (FWBC) race committee, protest committee, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this event. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law

12. Insurance

12.1. Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$500,000.00 per incident.

13. Sustainability Statement

13.1 This is a Clean Regatta, all competitors are strongly encouraged to use multi-use water bottles instead of disposable water bottles, and to recycle whenever possible. A competitor shall not intentionally put trash in the water. See RRS 47.
