NOTICE OF RACE

ORGANIZING AUTHORITY: Ocean Spring Sailing Squadron and Division 15

VENUE: Spectacular Mississippi Sound at OSYC, Ocean Springs, MS

RULES: The regatta shall be governed by the rules as defined in the current Racing Rules of Sailing.

CLASSES: Regatta is open to all Hobie 16s.

ELIGIBILITY: As per IHCA class rule 26, all competitors shall be paid-up members in good standing a National Hobie Class Association or Hobie fleet in good standing with the IHCA. World Sailing Competitor's Eligibility Code Regulation 19.15 applies.

A competitor who has represented one country and who has another nationality, has changed his nationality, or has acquired a new nationality shall not represent his new country unless:

- (a) he has not represented his old country within the last three years;
- (b) and at least three years has passed since such change or acquisition.

CONDITIONS OF ELIGIBILITY: All competitors must provide a completed and signed Release and Waiver of Liability form. Each competitor under the age of 18 years old on September 12, 2026 shall bring a completed form signed by a parent/guardian.

INSURANCE: Each team must obtain a certificate from their insurance company/agent that reflects year, type and ID number of the boat insured with their liability limits which is to be a minimum of \$100,000 USD.

ADVERTISING: All boats shall display advertising of the event sponsor(s) as required by the OA. Individual sponsorship conflicting with the event sponsor's business category shall not be allowed. Competitors may be required to carry cameras from the OA.

MEASUREMENT: Boats will be weighed and/or measured at the event. See schedule of events for dates and times. Competitors are responsible for complying with their respective Class Rules. During the competition, any boat may be subject to inspection.

PENALTY SYSTEM: Rule 44.1 is changed so that only a One-Turn Penalty is required, one tack and one gybe.

RADIO COMMUNICATIONS: VHF radios are recommended with use/restrictions in the Sailing Instructions.

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: Shall be available online by September 5, 2026 and on-site during event.

TROPHIES: Will be awarded as soon as possible after last race on Sunday.
