NOTICE OF RACE

1. Organizing Authority

- The organizing authority for this regatta is the Dana West Youth Sailing (DWYS). The DWYS Race Committee will manage this regatta and shall have sole authority to apply the rules and conditions of the race and appoint a protest committee.

2. Rules

- The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS). Following that, a US Coast Guard Approved PFD shall be worn at all times by competitors while on the water, other than brief periods while adding or removing clothing

3. Eligibility and Entry

- This regatta is open to ALL AGE skippers of the RS Tera Sport class. Entry is \$30 per boat. Registration is open at <https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/30696>

4. Penalty System

- For all classes, RRS 44.1, Taking a Penalty, is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

6. Venue and Courses

- The racing area will be in the ocean behind the jetty across from the island's Richard Henry Dana statue. The Sailing Instructions will include a course chart and schedule of races.

7. Support, Coaching, and Coach Boats

- Team leaders, coaches, and other support personnel shall stay outside areas where boats are racing from the time of the preparatory signal until all boats have finished the race or the race committee signals a postponement, general recall or abandonment.
- Coach boats will not be provided by the regatta organizers. It is upon the responsibility of the coach to bring a boat or acquire a charter.

8. Boat Charters

- A limited supply of boat charters are available at an estimated \$30 per boat. Please visit the event website and click on View Online Storefront.

9. Scoring

- The Low-Point Scoring System, RRS Appendix A will apply. A boat's total score will be the sum of her scores for all races.

- Sailing Instructions will be posted no later than Wednesday (4/08/2026). Any changes to the sailing instructions will be posted no later than 30 minutes after the skippers meeting.

- Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

- Boats will rig and launch from the OC Sailing & Events Center (OCSEC) located at 34451 Ensenada Pl, Dana Point, CA 92629 or the slip in front of Dana West Yacht Club (DWYC) located at 24601 Dana Drive, Dana Point, CA 92629. Visiting boats will store their trailers in the designated area of the DWYC parking lot. Racers will check-in, rig their boats and attend the Skipper's Meeting at DPYC at 0930.
