1. RULES

- A. The race shall be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2025-2028, including US Sailing & HYRA Prescriptions unless otherwise amended in this Notice of Race or the Sailing Instructions.

2. ADVERTISING

- A. Advertising shall comply with ISAF Regulation 20. Competitor advertising will not be restricted.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- A. The regatta is open to all yachts that are members of HYRA member clubs, and other yachts that may be invited by the organizing authorities.
- B. Eligible yachts may enter via the US Sailing Regatta Network website. Entries will only be accepted using the Regatta Network website <http://www.regattanetwork.com/html/calendar.html>.
- C. Entry deadline 11:59pm, Wednesday April 29, 2026 for regular entry fee. No entries will be accepted after Friday May 1, 2026

4. FEES

- A. Required fees are as follows:

6. MEASUREMENTS

- A. Each boat racing in PHRF Class X, A, or B, shall have a valid YRA / NCPHRF Northern California Performance Handicap Racing Fleet handicap certificate valid for 2025 or 2026. No exceptions, except for a new boat entering the fleet. Cruising class boats can have an assigned rating based on the NCPHRF Base rating. The NCPHRF certificate application can be found at WWW.YRA.org

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- A. Sailing instructions will be available on Regatta Network.

8. SCORING

- A. Corrected times will be calculated using the PHRF Time-on-Time scoring system, as adopted by HYRA.
- B. The low point system of RRS Appendix A shall apply without modification.

9. PRIZES

- A. For each class a first prize will be awarded if at least three boats enter, second prize will be awarded if at least five boats enter, and third prize will be awarded if at least seven boats enter.

10. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- A. The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or continue racing is hers alone. See RRS Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

11. INSURANCE

- A. Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$500,000 per event or the equivalent. A copy of certificate will be required at time of registration.
