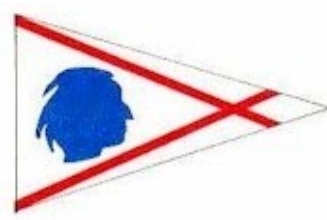

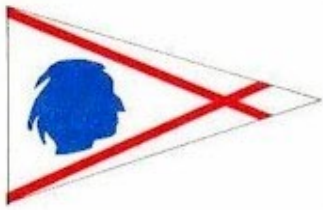

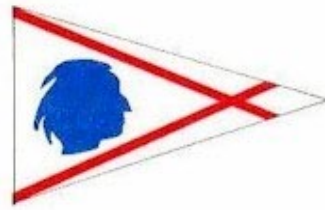

1. **Rules:** This regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined by the current edition of the *Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*.
2. **Eligibility:**
 - a. Flying Scot:
Open to all Flying Scot sailors and **are not required** to be members of the FSSA for scoring or participation in regatta.
 - i. FSSA membership is required for consideration of scoring to Florida District Champion.
 - b. Catalina 22:
 - i. Open to all Catalina 22 Sailors. Florida Catalina 22 sailors will be scored for the Florida Catalina 22 Championship.
3. **Registration** may be completed at <https://www.regattanetwork.com/html/calendar.php>.
 - All Flying Scot boats will sail in the Championship Division.
 - Sailing Instructions will be available to registrants at registration.
 - Online registration will be available.

4. **Fees:** Regatta registration fee \$50.00 per boat.
5. **Schedule:** At least five races are planned. The skipper's meeting will be at 10:30 at the Lee Wenner Pavilion.
6. **Measurement:** Flying Scot boats and sails must conform to the Official Plan. Each boat must carry equipment required by FSSA Specification Article S-V.2 (Racing Restrictions).
7. **Courses to be Sailed:** Courses to be sailed will be windward / leeward as described in the Sailing Instructions.
8. **Berthing:** It is recommended that the boats be kept on their trailers overnight.
9. **Scoring:** The low-point scoring system of RRS Appendix A2 will be used.
 - 5 races minimum are scheduled, of which 1 must be completed to constitute a Regatta.
 - If more than 5 races are completed competitors will be able to throw out their worst score(s).
10. **Prizes:** Awards will be presented to the top 3 boats of the Regatta (all classes).

Additional information:

The Regatta will take place on the beautiful Indian River South of Cocoa Village. Boats can launch at Lee Wenner Park which has a sheltered basin to launch boats and launch ramp parking to store boats/trailers for the weekend. If you are traveling and searching for a hotel we recommend searching in Cocoa, Cocoa Beach and/or Port Canaveral. Kennedy Space Center, Cocoa Beach and historic Cocoa Village are all a short distance from the Regatta site. A new B&B opened up in Cocoa Village, Parish Grove Inn--walking distance to the regatta.
